Final Budget Public Hearing

CM Scott presented the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Budget. A copy of the Final Budget is attached to the original minutes.

The public hearing opened.

Resolution No. 2018R-40

CM Scott read Resolution No. 2018R-40. A resolution adopting the final levying of Ad Valorem Taxes for Columbia County for the Fiscal Year 2018-2019 and setting the final millage rate for the Columbia County Board of County Commissioners at 8.015 mills for the 2018-2019 fiscal year, which is more than the rolled back rate of 7.7511 by 3.4%.

Bid No. 2018-J – Alligator Lake Pier Restoration

Staff recommended awarding the bid for the renovation to Alligator Lake Pier to the low bidder, Hayward Construction Group, LLC in the amount of \$67,375.

MOTION by Commissioner Williams to award Bid No. 2018-J to the low bidder, Hayward Construction Group, LLC in the amount of \$67,375. SECOND by Commissioner Nash. The motion carried unanimously.

BA 18-68 – Community Center Utility Account

The community center utility account is in need of \$30,000 to complete the remainder of the year. There have been several projects that have caused the utility bills to increase.

MOTION by Commissioner Nash to approve BA 18-68 in the amount of \$30,000 for community center and recreation center utility charges. SECOND by Commissioner Williams. The motion carried unanimously.

BA 18-69 – School Resource Officer

This budget amendment is the funds for the additional resource officer for the remainder of the fiscal year.

MOTION by Commissioner Williams to approve BA 18-69 in the amount of \$84,650 for an additional school resource officer. SECOND by Commissioner Phillips. The motion carried unanimously.
