MINIMUM MOBILE HOME STANDARDS (See Pg for more detailed information.)

- Homes must have at least 450 sq. ft. and be 10 feet wide. Must meet HUD, ANSI, or county codes.
- Home must be in sound condition with working windows, doors, electric, and heating.
- Used homes must pass pre-inspection and meet wind zone II requirements.
- Final inspections for blocking, tie-downs, steps, mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and septic must be completed.
