Addendum One

The bid document is silent on what happens to recyclables picked up at the curbside. Does the contractor or the County own the rights to that material? If the County owns the rights to the material, where will the contractor deliver the material for processing? **County owns rights to materials, to be delivered to Winfield Solid Waste Facility**

How is the tonnage of yard trash determined if it is received at the County landfill mixed with solid waste in one truck? **Only tonnage that is separated is the bulk item pickups.**

Please confirm the County landfill currently receives approximately 8.5 tons per month from Class one industrial services and approximately 93 tons per month from Class three industrial services. **Refer to Commercial Tonnage information listed under addendums.**

Pg 8. 3. Bid Security...bid bond based on 5 % of contract amount - is contract amount based only on residential base bid price X number of residential units X 12 months, not including commercial and roll off? If commercial and roll off revenues are to be included, there is no information in bid documents on the quantity of these services - only bid price forms on pages 24 and 25. **Residential bid price only.**

Pg 9. Scope of Work - second sentence - Is the residential solid waste and yard waste (bagged or bundled) collection performed once/week a combined collection - both picked up at same time into one truck? Fifth sentence - options - is leaf and limb service a separate yard trash collection, separate truck? **Currently it is a combined pickup, the option would be for a separate pickup.**

Pg 10. last paragraph under Scope of Work - confirm that contractor will bill County quarterly for residential collection services (County pays contractor quarterly, not monthly). **Yes it is Quarterly as per bid specs**

Pg 11. Disposal Site Residential - confirm that there is no disposal charge to contractor for residential waste delivered to County's landfill. **Yes as per bid specs**

Pg 18. 19. Bond - performance bond in amount of 100 % of annual contract amount - same question as above question on bid bond - what are quantities of commercial and roll off services needed to calculate those revenues? **Residential bid price only.**

Pg 20. Base Bid (No Price Adjustments) and Pg 23. Alternate Bid (Annual Fuel Adjustment) - confirm that there is no CPI increases on either the Base Bid or the Alternate Bid over the entire term of contract. **Yes it is Quarterly as per bid specs**

Does the 12% franchise fee apply to temporary class III roll-off accounts? **NO.**
Temporary is defined as 120 days or less at a location.

The commercial tonnage in the bid specification shows 924 tons per month, the landfill information sheet shows 653.47 tons per month. Roll-off container services shows 8.5 tons per month for class I in the bid specs and the landfill information sheet shows 85.40 tons per month. Roll-off services in the bid specs for class III shows 93 tons per month and the landfill information sheet shows 185.69 per month. What are the correct numbers that we should use? **Refer to Commercial Tonnage information listed under addendums.**

Will the terms of the Waste Pro contract apply to the new contractor? In particular, page 11 - semi annual cleanups, page 17- 10% discount on county locations, page 23 - indigent service free for the first 200 residents? All terms apply with the exception of 10% discount for county locations. **Any discount shall be reflected in the final bid for county locations that are listed separately on the bid form.**
