

## ADDENDUM 2 2016-E

1. Page 4 line #35, of the information to bidders, it states that the contract may be cancelled by the County **with or without** cause on 30 days advance written notice. However, section 17 “Terms” of the RFB basically states that the contractor will have 30 days to work with the county to rectify any potential service issues. Will the County consider striking Line #35 but keep section 17 “terms” with the exception of changing the timeline from 30 to 60 days?  
**The general instructions to bidders are just that, general. If the RFP or contract language contradicts those instructions the RFP or contract language will take president.**
2. Section 6, Scope of Work, it states that residential units produce approx. 1,665 tons of waste per month. Does this include yard waste? **YES**, Will the County please provide monthly yard waste tonnages? **Not tracked, collected with regular collection**
3. What is the disposal cost for “Industrial Waste” at the County Landfill? **Class I Industrial is \$52.00 Class III Industrial \$37.00**
4. Please confirm that the “leaf and limb” size/weight requirements is consistent with “yard waste” size/weight requirements. **Dimensions and weight are the same**
5. Does the current commercial rates include the 12% franchise fee? **County collects 12% franchise fee, haulers bills accordingly**
6. Is the current commercial dumpster rate and commercial toter rate hauling and disposal, or just hauling? **Hauler pays disposal, hauler bills accordingly**
7. Will the County please provide a monthly hauling average for **each** roll-off and compactor, per location, along with the average tons per haul? **Hauler bills customer, County bills hauler for disposal. County does not track each individual customer.**
8. Will the County please provide the last three months of detailed franchise fee reports? **No formal report is available at this time.**
9. Will the County please provide a copy of the residential route maps along with the type of equipment currently being utilized? **County has no route maps**
10. Is the County currently receiving any free dumpster service from the current vendor? I.e., special events or County buildings? If so, how many buildings/events and what type of containers are being utilized? **The present service agreement requires the Collector to “ Place roll-off containers in up to five (5) separate locations as designated by the County, one locartion at a time , for a total of five consecutive weeks. The Collector will incur the costs except disposal. This requirement has varied as to the number of times and locations in a year.**
11. Upon award of the contract, will the County consider allowing the successful bidder to submit collection routes and maps 60 days prior to start of the contract? **YES**
