Residential, Commercial and Industrial Solid Waste  
Q/A

1. What is the desired collection frequency per week for the optional contracts - Recycling, Leaf & Limb and Bulk Yard Debris? **Once a Week**
2. Can the small commercial solid waste and the residential solid waste be collected in the same truck? **No, must be collected separately.**
3. In the example within the fuel adjustment rates chapter, can you clarify that the new rate should be \$11.44 instead of \$11.044. Example:  $(\$3.00 - \$2.00) / \$2.00 \times 8\% = 4\%$ . So  $\$11.00 \times (1 + 0.04) = \$11.44$  **\$11.44 would be correct.**
4. Does the county pay for disposal separately or should the rates include disposal costs? **County pays for residential disposal. Contractor pays for Commercial disposal.**
5. Does the current residential rate of \$9.45/month/unit include disposal or this is the rate just for the hauling? **Hauling only. Disposal is billed to the County.**
6. In the option "contractor supplied carts", do we have to propose carts for all materials or just for Solid Waste and/or recycling? **Solid Waste only.**
7. Does the current provider collect commercial and/or industrial waste on Saturdays? **Commercial Collection is done on Saturdays.**
8. Is the current dumpster commercial tonnage (924 Tons/month) correct? According to the data provided in addendum 1, the current provider is collecting about 11,000 cu yd/month. Based on the 11,000 cu yd/month, the average weight would be around 185 lb/cu yd, which is very high based on industry averages. Could you confirm either the 924 tons/month or the 11,000 cu yd/month are correct? **The tonnage is all inclusive of Commercial dumpsters and toters.**
9. Should disposal costs be included within the recycling, leaf & limb and bulk yard waste rates? **County pays for all residential disposal cost.**
10. Concerning the garbage 95 gal cart bid number- Is this for contents of cart only or our we also responsible for trash/debris outside cart? **One 95 gallon cart contents only.**
11. Curbside Recycling- What size containers does the county prefer? Is the recycling going to be Single stream in one large container or dual sort recycling in smaller containers such as 18 gallons? **Single Stream, 18 Gal.**
