Q&A

1. What kind of “Proposed Contract” are you referring to on page 5 of 17 for Tab 6?
A. Proposer shall provide a formed contract that may be considered by the County. Any proposed contract shall be subject to negotiation with the County and approval by the County in the event the Proposer received an award to provide the required services.

2. Has the County established a budget for the project? If so, could the County please provide this information?
A. Approximately \$200,000.

3. On page 4 of the RFQ, Tab 3: Qualifications of Staff states that “All professionals assigned to the project must be licensed in the State of Florida”. Often, our teams are made up of production staff, subject matter experts, and other design support personnel that are highly qualified to work on a project of this nature that aren’t licensed. Can the County please clarify which roles must have a FL license?
A. Principal personnel to be assigned to the project (such as architects, engineers, etc.)

4. Due to the rapid expansion of COVID-19, the virus's ability to survive on inanimate objects for a duration of time and, out of an abundance of caution to keep everyone safe and healthy, would the County be willing to accept a digital copy of our submittal in lieu of hard copies?
