Remarks Local Option While mopping up a previous fire (see reports 7327 & 7472) we noticed another structure fire and started. We proceeded to the next fire. Upon our arrival we found a 2 story structure had started in the laundry room and optically involved. Structure had an office on one end of the 1st floor. The other side was a tool storage room and a public laundry room. The fire started in the laundry room and extended to the tool storage room. The 2nd floor was a residence which had minor heat and smoke damage. We extinguished the fire in the laundry room. The office and 2nd story were ventilated via Engine 48's PPV fan. We checked for extension after fire was extinguished and then started mop up mode. We were starting to wind up on this fire and noticed another mobile home on fire. Engine 42 and Engine 48 crews went to the 3rd fire. Sheriff's deputy arrived on scene and arrested a possible arsonist. Florida State Fire Marshal's office was called in to investigate possible arson fires. Witnesses stated they saw a suspected arsonist try to start another trailer on fire and he was apprehended by the sheriff's deputies. Mop up was completed and all hazards secured. Scene was turned over to Chief atkinson and State Fire Marshal. All units completed assignment and returned to station.
