Our office reviewed the referenced projects in accordance with Chapter 267, Florida Statutes, and implementing state regulations, for possible effects on historic properties listed, or eligible for listing, in the National Register of Historic Places, or otherwise of historical, architectural or archaeological value.

We note that the structure included in this undertaking is Morell House (8CO1106). Currently, this office does not have sufficient information to determine whether the house is eligible for listing in the NRHP. However, based on the information provided, it is the opinion of this office that the proposed undertakings should have no adverse effect on the structure.
