# MINCIDENT NARRATIVE

Batt. 48 responded with E-48 and T-48 to the above location in reference to a structure fire. Enroute dispatch advised the homeowner was burning yard debris and it spread to the residents. Batt. 48 arrived on-scene with E-48 and T-48 to a single-family dwelling with heavy smoke coming from the eaves. E-48 crew pulled 200ft of 1.75" pre-connect with fog nozzle and made access through the front door of the residents to search for active fire in the attic. E-48 crew member advised power was shut off at the main breaker and no active fire was inside of the residents. E-48 crew with an attic ladder gained access into the attic and advised there was no signs of active fire, just insulation smoldering. All additional incoming units arrived onscene with assignments to check for fire extension, ventilate, salvage and overhaul. PPV fan was established at the front door to clear smoke out of the residents. Smoke was cleared out of the residents using the PPV fan and opening windows. Homeowner advised to CF2 that she was burning yard debris in an open fire pit near the residents. She advised the A/D corner of the residents was involved with active fire and it worked its way up into the attic space. Homeowner advised she tried extinguishing the flames using her garden hose until the pump shut off. E-48 crew member checked resident multiple times using a thermal image camera. Salvage and overhaul were complete by all fire units on-scene. No additional hazards were present. Batt. 48 advised to dispatch that the situation was under control, all fire unit's assignment complete, available and scene turn over to homeowner.
