Based on the information provided to the Suwannee River Water Management District (District), the subject proposed project has met the qualifications found in subsection 62-330.315, F.A.C., and qualifies for a minor modification of the existing permit. This minor modification is hereby in effect for the activity description below:

The previous master permit was for the construction and operation of a surfacewater management system serving 6.17 acres of impervious surface on a total project area of 1,000 acres. This minor modification authorizes the construction of a new restroom facility on previously permitted impervious area. The stormwater runoff from this activity was authorized under the master permit ERP-023-205605-1 issued on January 17, 1991. The design engineer has certified that the proposed conditions do not exceed the allowable conditions of the master system. The project shall be constructed in accordance with the application package submitted by David T. Matson and plans submitted and certified by Benjamin Lennon, P.E., DRMP on or before May 5, 2023.

The permittee shall adhere to all permit conditions and/or requirements as well as perform anyrequired reporting, monitoring, or inspections in accordance with the original permit.

This authorization does not exempt you from obtaining permits from any other regulatory agency. Any modifications to the authorized plans shall require reconsideration by the District prior to commencement of construction.
