We recommend removing damaged or wet sheetrock, insulation, base cabinets, and vanity sink in Bedroom 2, Hall Bath, Laundry Room, Hall, Linen Closet, Utility room, and Master Bathroom as well as all vinyl flooring throughout. Once that is completed and removed from the property and all debris out of the way, we will need to clean up the best we can, do an antimicrobial treatment and utilize drying equipment to dry out the framing, studs, wall cavity, subflooring, etc... Normally it takes about 3 days to dry out the frame/structural components so that is what we base our estimate on. If it takes longer for some reason the price would increase.
