
## **Electrical Plan Notes**

- E-1 Wire all appliances, HVAC units and other equipment per manufacture specifications.
- E-2 Consult the owner for the number of seperate telephone lines to be installed. Owner is responsible for all overages not noted on plan.
- E-3 All intallations shall be per national electric code.
- E-4 All smoke detectors shill be 120v with battery backup of the photoelectrick type, and shall be interlocked together. Install inside and near all bedrooms.
- E-5 Telephone, television and other low voltage devices or outlets shall be as per the owners directions, and in accordance with applicable sections of National Electric Codes latest edition.
- E-6 Electical contractor shall be responsible for the design and sizing of electrical service and circuits.
- E-7 Entry of service (underground or overhead to be determined by contractor agreement.
- E-8 All bedroom receptacles shall be AFCI (arc fault circuit interrupter)
- E-9 All outlet to be located above base flood elevation.
- E-10 All exterior GFI outlets shall be weather proof.
