FIREBLOCKING SHALL BE INSTALLED IN WOOD FRAME CONSTRUCTION IN THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:

- 1. IN CONCEALED SPACES OF STUD WALLS AND PARTITIONS INCLUDING FURRED SPACES AT CEILING AND FLOOR LEVELS.
- 2. AT ALL INTERCONNECTIONS BETWEEN CONCEALED VERTICAL AND HORIZONTAL SPACES SUCH AS OCCUR AT SOFFITS, DROP CEILINGS, COVE CEILINGS, ETC.

FASTENERS FOR ASPHALT SHINGLES SHALL BE GALVANIZED, STAINLESS STEEL, ALUMINUM OR COPPER ROOFING NAILS, MINIMUM 12 GAUGE SHANK WITH A MINIMUM 3/8 INCH DIAMETER HEAD, OF A LENGTH TO PENETRATE THROUGH THE ROOFING MATERIAL AND A MINIMUM 3/4" INTO THE ROOF SHEATHING. WHERE THE SHEATHING IS LESS THAN 3/4" THICK, THE NAILS SHALL PENETRATE THROUGH THE SHEATHING.

- APPLIED PARALLEL WITH THE EAVE AND FASTENED SUFFICIENTLY TO STAY IN PLACE.
- 2. STARTING AT THE EAVE, 36 INCH WIDE STRIPS OF UNDERLAYMENT FELT SHALL BE APPLIED OVERLAPPING SUCCESSIVE SHEETS 19 INCHES AND FASTENED SUFFICIENTLY TO STAY IN PLACE.

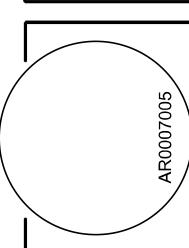

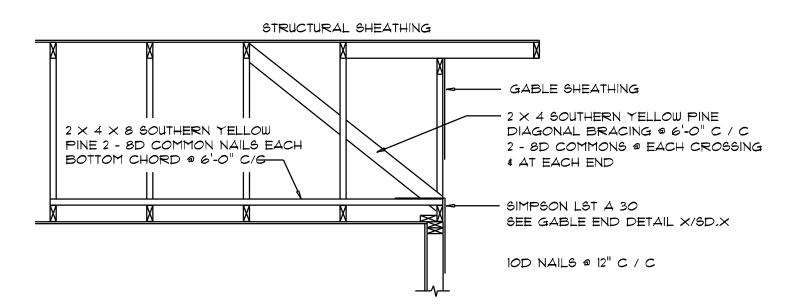

GABLE END GYPSUM DIAPHRAGM HOLDOWN CONNECTOR

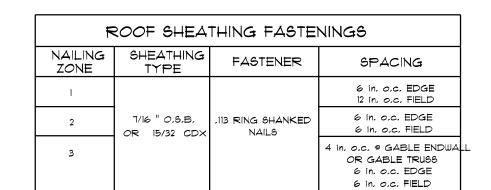

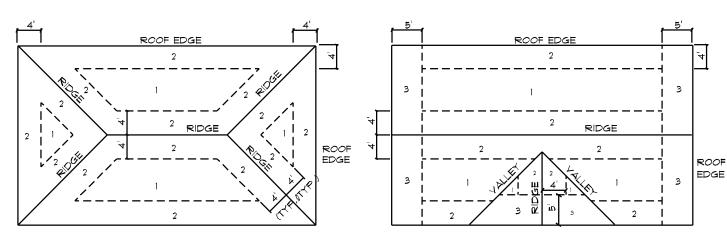


END WALL BRACING FOR CEILING DIAPHRAGM

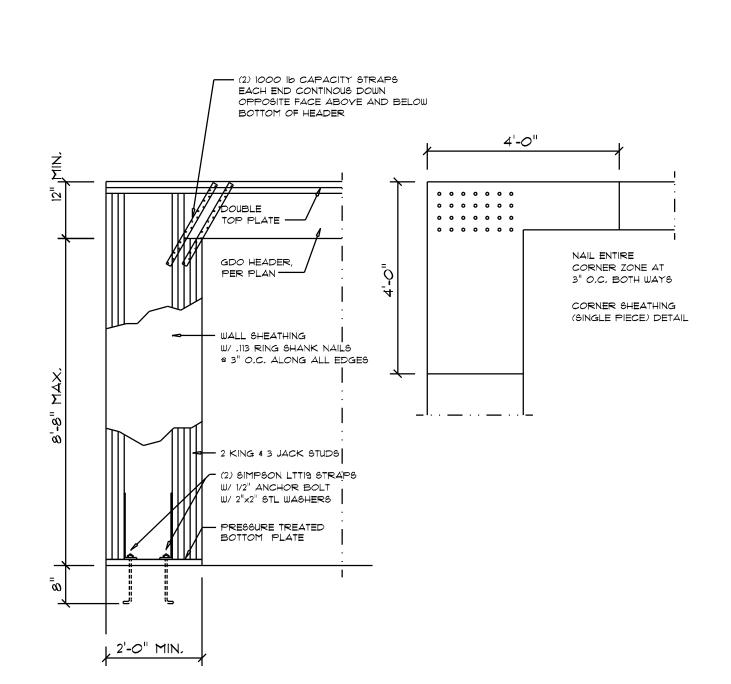


ROOF SHEATHING NAILING ZONES (HIP ROOF)

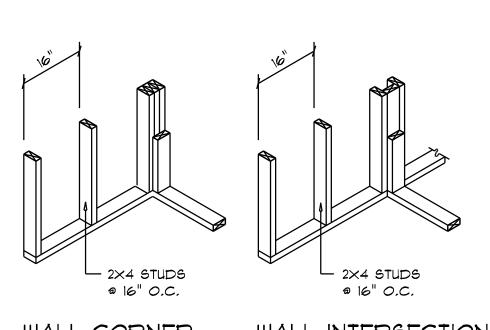
ROOF SHEATHING NAILING ZONES (GABLE ROOF)

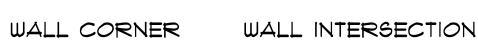

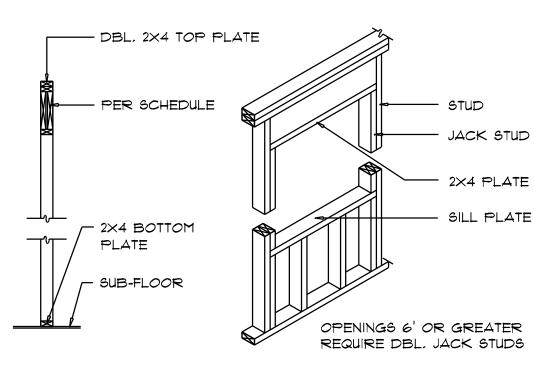




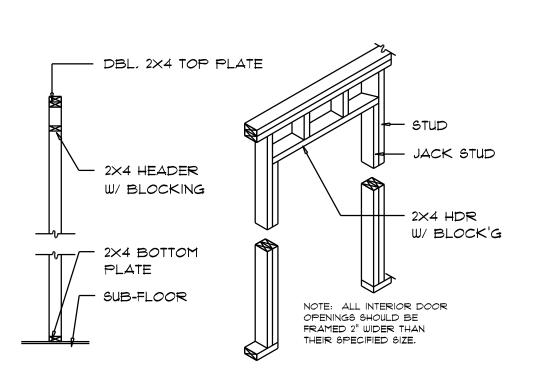




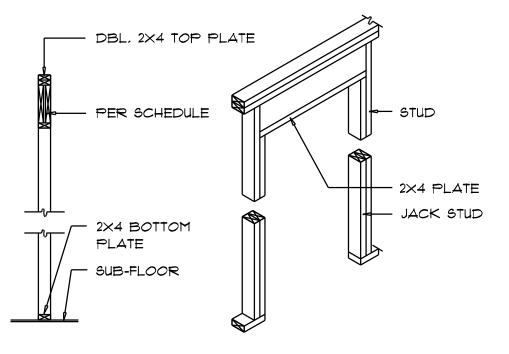




TYPICAL WINDOW HEADER

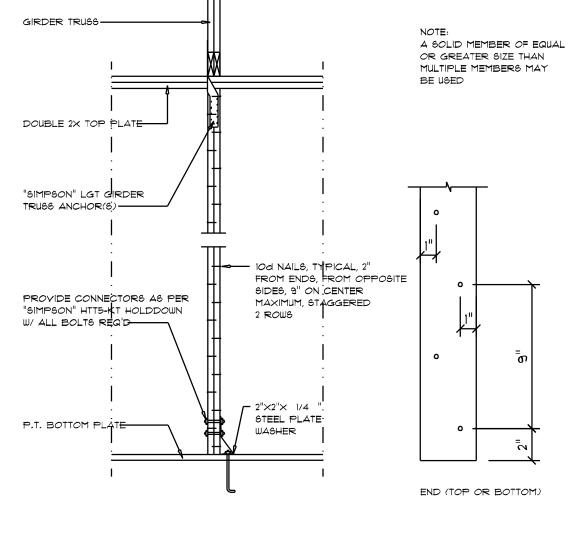


NON-BEARING WALL HEADER



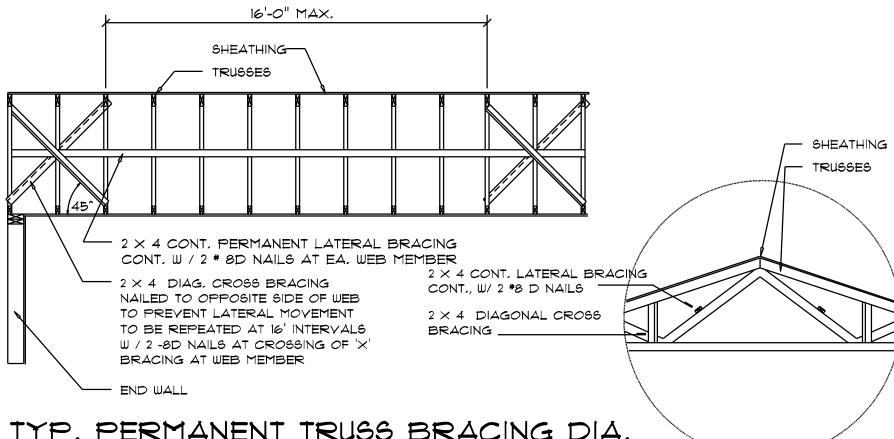
BEARING WALL HEADER

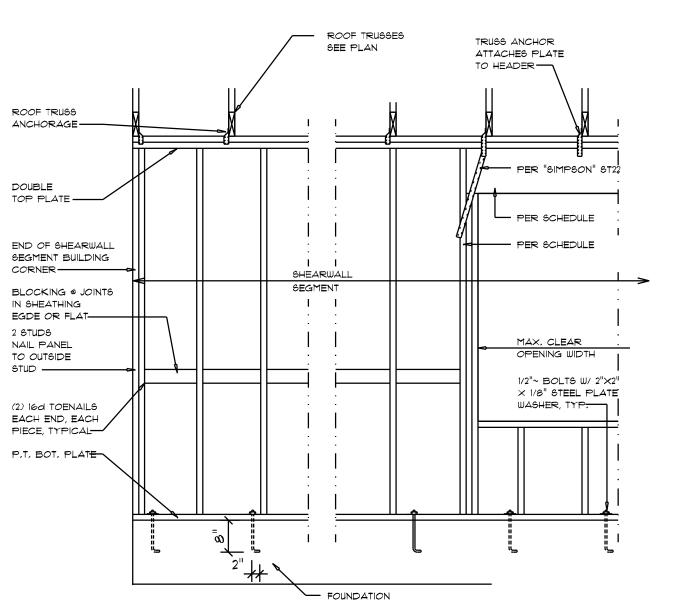
