INCIDENT NARRATIVE

This call is in the City limits of High springs. See their report for the main narrative.

E-21 arrived on scene as second suppression unit. Command requested E-21 supply the rural hitch to E-29. E-21 supplied water to the rural hitch with a 3" supply line and coordinated supply pressure with E-29. E-21 driver was assigned water supply and E-21 Lt. proceeded to the scene. E-21 Lt. assigned R-20 personnel and ordered by command to make entry and assist with pulling ceiling and fire attack.

E-21 D/O coordinated with tanker crews to set up drafting operations. Water supply used from T-21 to pump rural hitch while E-21 set up the dump tank and pulled a draft. Once complete, water supply was re-established, flowing from E-21. Tanker shuttle operations begun and maintained by E-21 D/O (water supply)

INCIDENT NARRATIVE

E-21 made entry on the alpha side PAR three. E-21 encountered moderate smoke with flames seen in the ceiling and floor in the B/C corner of the structure. The floor was found to be spongy, and command was advised of the risks. While pulling ceiling it was found that the fire had traveled out of the bedroom and was in the floor and ceiling of the kitchen on the Charlie side of the structure. Crews were able to make access to the fire above and below and extinguished it before it could proceed further.

Once suppression operations were completed overhaul was commenced. While overhaul was being performed, a third search of the unaffected area of the structure found the homeowners cat hiding in some boxes. Cat was taken to a waiting ambulance, treated for smoke inhalation, then released to homeowner. After overhaul was complete, E-21 remained on scene to assisted with collection of tools, hose and equipment. After all equipment was accounted for all units were released by command.

Unit Narrative

Dispatched for residential structure fire. Prior to arrival was advised that the fire had burned through the roof. Upon arrival, found a double wide mobile home. Crews were completing overhaul. First due crews advised that they found fire coming from the roof on the B/C corner of the structure. When they entered the structure, they found greyish smoke throughout. When entering the bedroom located on the B/C corner, they noted very little fire and a soft floor.

360-degree exterior survey completed in a counterclockwise direction. Smoke damage noted coming from the vents under the house. Fire damage noted coming from underneath the structure traveling up the exterior on the C side near the B/C corner. Due to weak floors in the structure, an interior survey was not conducted. Examination of the bedroom on the B/C corner was made from the exterior window. Fire tracing leads to underneath the structure close to the east wall of the bedroom.

Unit Narrative

When speaking with the owner, she advised that she woke up smelling smoke. The smoke detectors had not gone off at that point. The owner advised that were cleaning out the house as it was to be moved to a new location the following day. She advised that the bedroom in the B/C corner was empty at the time of the fire. She also advised that she smelled what she described as electrical burning.

Fire is ruled accidental.
