Dear Mr. Pollock:

Thank you for your letter dated August 12, 2008, explaining your hardship with constructing a water quality pond as part of your permit. When the total impervious area of a project is less than the threshold of 10,890 square-feet, an engineered, 100-year critical pond, which could retain up to 16 inches in 10 days, is not required. However, when the impervious area begins to approach the threshold, you may be required to provide a water quality pond, which will retain a 2 inch storm. This pond can be negated if the applicant shows that runoff water will be treated enough to meet state minimum water quality treatment requirements. This can be achieved by having the runoff water sheet flow through a grassed field before discharging offsite. According to your letter, there will be a grassed, open spaced area for runoff to sheet flow through before entering the stormwater system along US Highway 90. That being the case, the water quality pond is not required as part of your construction.

Please construct the remainder of the project as permitted in the plans. When construction is finished, please complete the As-Built Verification form that was included in your application package and submit a site plan that shows the completed construction. (This plan should not include the pond).

General Conditions for All Noticed General Permits:

6. The permittee is hereby advised that s.253.77, F.S., states that a person may not commence any excavation, construction or other activity involving the use of sovereign or other lands of the state, the title to which is vested in the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund without obtaining the required lease, license, easement, or other form of consent authorizing the proposed use. Therefore, the permittee is responsible for obtaining any necessary authorizations from the Board of Trustees prior to commencing activity on sovereignty lands or other state-owned lands.

The permittee shall implement best management practices for erosion, turbidity and other pollution control to prevent violation of state water quality standards. 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

A petition must comply with Chapter 28-106, Florida Administrative Code.

If the Governing Board takes action which substantially differs from the notice of District decision to grant or deny the permit application, a person whose substantial interests are or may be determined has the right to request an administrative hearing or may choose to pursue mediation as an alternative remedy as described above. Pursuant to Rule 28-106.111, Florida Administrative Code, the petition must be filed at the office of the District Clerk at District Headquarters, 9225 C.R. 49, Live Oak, Florida 32060 within twenty-one (21) days of receipt of written notice of the decision or within twenty-one (21) days of newspaper publication of the notice of District decision (for those persons to whom the District does not mail actual notice). Such a petition must comply with Chapter 28-106, Florida Administrative Code.
3. A substantially interested person has the right to a formal administrative hearing pursuant to Section 120.569 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, where there is a dispute between the District and the party regarding an issue of material fact. A petition for formal hearing must comply with the requirements set forth in Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code.
4. A substantially interested person has the right to an informal hearing pursuant to Section 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes, where no material facts are in dispute. A petition for an informal hearing must comply with the requirements set forth in Rule 28-106.301, Florida Administrative Code.
5. A petition for an administrative hearing is deemed filed upon receipt of the petition by the Office of the District Clerk at the District Headquarters in Live Oak, Florida.
6. Failure to file a petition for an administrative hearing within the requisite time frame shall constitute a waiver of the right to an administrative hearing pursuant to Rule 28-106.111, Florida Administrative Code.

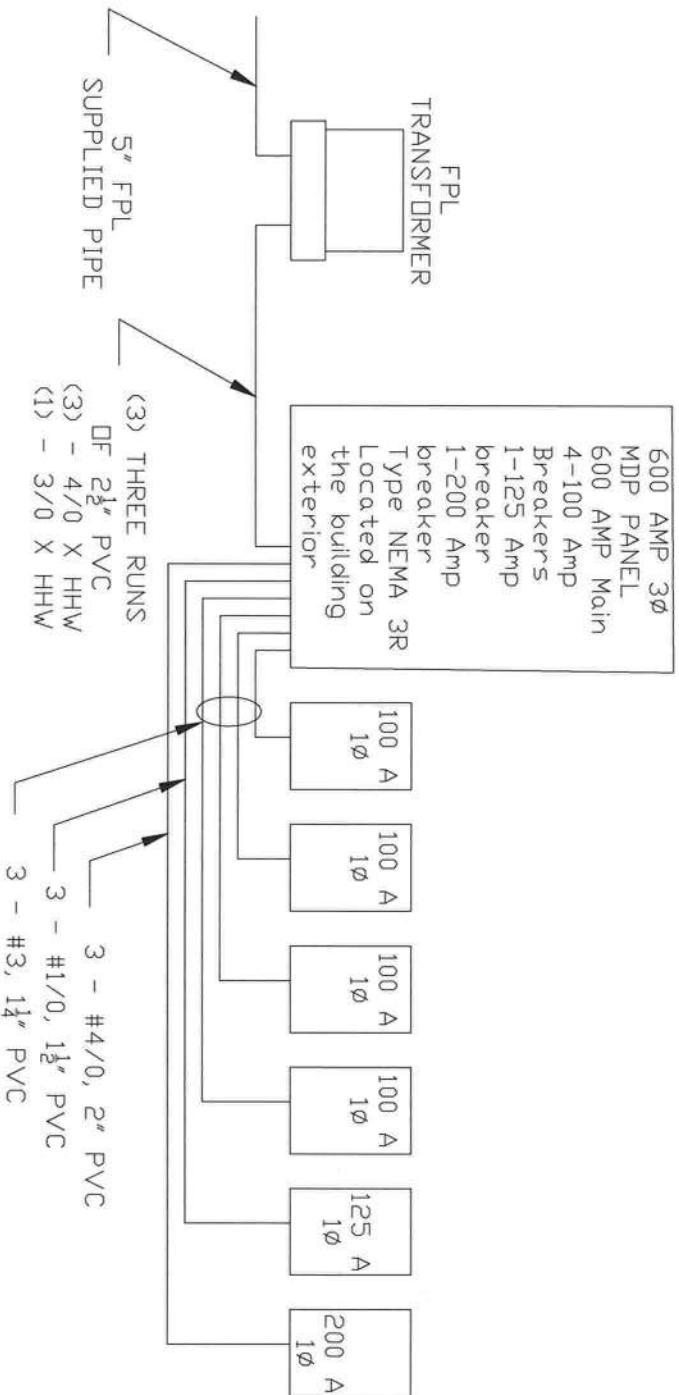
