Units were dispatched to a residential structure fire. First arriving found a two-story block structure with fire vented through the roof in the middle of the structure. Power was secured to the residence and crews made entry with one preconnected attack line to find the inside lower story of the home clear of smoke or fire. All occupants were confirmed out of the structure with a quick primary search. Upon going upstairs crews found a ceiling fan and light fixture dropped from the ceiling and fire in the attic space above it. Ceiling was pulled and crews extinguished the fire that was well involved in the attic space. Crews began mopping the fire up and removing valuables and essentials from the home for property conservation. Once the fire was fully mopped up, the owner was contacted about what had occurred. Owner stated they were unaware of any fire going on until they noticed shadows in the sunlight in the back yard, they went outside and saw the smoke coming from the roof and contacted emergency services. Investigation of the home found all breakers in the panel box for the upstairs tripped. Upstairs a ceiling fan was located on the floor with the junction box melted to it. The fire appears to have started on or around where the fan was mounted to the ceiling. A phone consult with State Fire Marshall Ryan Dixon was made and he was confident in determining the fire to be accidental electrical in cause based on information and photos given to him via phone. Contact was made with Red Cross for three adults and two dogs. Scene was turned over to the owners and all units cleared the scene.

44 units were dispatched to the above location for a structure on fire. Upon our arrival, flames and smoke were coming through the roof of a already vented 2 story residential structure, with 45 crew setting up Engine 45 with water supply and hose lines for attack. All occupants were out of the building. DE Archer and FF Raines made entry through the front door with a charged 1 3/4" line, no smoke encountered in the living area. At the top of the stair case a ceiling fan was found on the floor and fire was noticed through the mounting area of the fan, we made our way to the bathroom, around the light fixture and the exhaust fan fire was noticed. The handline was used to cut through the drywall and extinguish the fire that was through the entire attic of the home. FF Cutford made his way upstairs and assisted with gaining access to the fire pulling wall drywall to the vaulted ceiling. Knockdown of the fire achieved, and overhaul was started. As our SCBA bottles need to be changed, we went to rehab.

All crews helped remove valuables in the heavy affected areas and brought them outside to protect them.

After clean-up 44 units went to station 48 to assist with putting all engines back in service, then went available.
