INCIDENT NARRATIVE

Engine 46 was dispatched to a private residence to a report of a residential structure fire. Prior to arrival Dispatch advised Engine 46 that homeowner was on scene advising fully involved and no persons were inside the residence. Engine 46 arrived on scene and found a single story double wide mobile home approximately 80 percent involved. Engine 46 established command. Engine 46 performed 360 and found a wooden shed on the Charlie side of the structure and notified incoming units that it was the only exposure. Engine 46 deployed and 1 3/4-inch handline and began a defensive attack on the Alpha side of the structure. Tanker 46 arrived on scene and established water supply. Tanker 46 crew deployed a second 1 3/4-inch handline to the Delta side of the structure to protect the exposure. Engine 44 arrived on scene and assisted in defensive attack on the Delta side of the structure. Engine 45 arrived on scene and assisted with defensive attack on Alpha side of the structure. Tanker 45 and Tanker 44 arrived on scene and assisted with water supply. Engine 48 arrived on scene and assisted with manpower. Battalion 48 arrived on scene and took over as Command. Units continued to perform fire extinguishment and once fire was under control units began mop up. After mop up was complete units cleared scene and were placed out of service for water and clean up. Owen Jr stated that they left at 1000-1030 this morning and arrived back at 1800 tonight where he saw fire in the residence. He tried to open the front door but was quickly overcome by smoke and heat. He broke out a window on the "A" side to try to get the dogs but was unable to. Fire marshal Det Robbins was called and responded incident # DFS24on0002219 for investigation. Fire appeared to have started on, near or around the washer, dryer and water heater in the laundry room, cause is found to be undetermined. Homeowner stated that there was no insurance on the residence.
