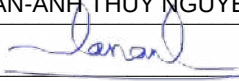

Note: All detached single family, duplex, triplex, and quadraplex structures must have their finished floor constructed at a minimum of eight (8) inches higher than the highest finished grade elevation next to the walls or foundation of the structure and a minimum of twelve (12) inches higher than the finished grade elevation at a distance of five (5) feet from the foundation of the structure. Structures located six (6) feet or less from the property line shall have their lowest finished floor elevation a minimum of twelve (12) inches higher than the highest finished grade elevation next to the walls or foundation of the structure. (Grading will be determined on site by the builder and County building inspector.)
