 - 3) Invest, reinvest, and make purchases with the income and principal of the Trust in every kind of property, asset, and investment;
 - 4) Borrow money from the Trust for trust purposes;

- exercise judgment over financial matters by reason of a medical illness or mental impairment;
- 17) Except as otherwise provided within the Declaration, to maintain all pets and animals currently supported by me by providing and paying for shelter, food, and veterinary care;
- 18) On the death of the Grantor, pay any just debts and expenses of the Grantor; and
- 19) Divide any trust created under the Trust into two (2) or more separate trusts having the same dispositive provisions.
- F. <u>Revocation</u>. The Trust is revocable, and the Grantor has the power to revoke the Trust at any time.
- G. The Trust has not been revoked, modified or amended in any manner which would cause the representations contained in this Certification of Trust to be incorrect. This Certification of Trust correctly states the terms and conditions under which the trust property is held, managed and disposed of by the Trustee. This Certification of Trust is being signed by all of the currently acting trustees of the trust.
