INCIDENT NARRATIVE

Crews were dispatched to 6067 SE CR 252 for a structure fire. Upon arrival found a fully involved multi story wood frame structure. E-48 crew began initial attack on the fire with a 2.5 inch handline in a defensive attack mode. Once other crews arrived and initial fire was knocked down two 1 3/4" handlines were deployed to continue extinguishment and a water shuttle was established to maintain supply. During operations the owner arrived on scene and stated that two dogs were in the structure. Crews later found the dogs that had perished in the fire and proceeded to take them outside to be covered with sheets. After the fire was extinguished crews began overhaul by pulling tin and extinguishing all hotspots. Fire Marshal was called and responded. Homeowner stated that he had a battery powered scooter, battery powered hover board and baby chickens with a heat lamp above them in the A/B corner inside the residence. Scene was turned over to Fire Marshal pending their investigation. No other hazards present, all units became available.
