To Whom It May Concern,

The following outlines the proposed utility connections for the property off Tyre Rd:

Water Line:

- A 12" x 8" water tap will need to be installed to run along the easement on Tyre Rd. This section will include hydrants within the right-of-way and will be turned over to the City upon completion.
- Upon reaching the subject property, two additional taps will be made:
 - An 8" x 2" tap for potable water.
 - An 8" x 6" tap for the fire main. If a hydrant is to be added, it will connect at this point.
- All water lines located within the property boundaries will be owned and maintained by AG Liquid.

Sewer Line:

- Although the original plan proposed a septic system, I recommend connecting to the existing 6" sewer main at the 90-degree bend using a 2" tap.
- The line will then be extended to the property, where a lift pump will be installed on-site.
