## INCIDENT NARRATIVE

DISPATCHED TO ADDRESS LISTED FOR A CONFIRMED STRUCTURE FIRE. ARRIVED ON SCENE WITH ENGINE 44 TO A WORKING STRUCTURE. A SINGLE STORY HOME THAT HAD ALREADY VENTED THROUGH THE ROOF. A 360 WAS COMPLETED OF THE STRUCTURE TO LOOK FOR HAZARDS. NO HAZARDS WERE FOUND. TWO PRECONNECTD WERE PULLED TO THE FRONT OF THE STRUCTURE FROM ENG 44. FIRE EXTINGUISMENT BEGAN AFTER ENG44 CREW GOT PACKED OUT. ENTRY WAS MADE THROUGH THE FRONT DOOR. AS OTHER CREWS ARRIVED ON SCENE THEY PACKED OUT AND ASSISTED EXTINGUISMENT UTILIZING THE OTHER PRECONNECT. THE FIRE HAD SPREAD THROUGH A SIGNIFICANT AMOUNT OF THE ATTIC CAUSING EXTENSIVE OVERHAUL ASWELL AS CAUSING SMOKE DAMAGE THROUGH OUT THE REST OF THE STRCUTURE. AFTER THE HEAVY FIRE WAS EXTINGUISHED THE CREWS MOVED TO ASSESING AND EXTINGUISHING HOT SPOTS. CREWS CLEANED UP AND PUT THEIR TRUCKS BACK IN SERVICE AFTER EXTINGUISMENT WAS COMPLETED.
