Certain uses are of short duration and do not create excessive incompatibility during the course of the use. Therefore, the Land Development Regulation Administrator is authorized to issue temporary use permits for the following activities, after a showing that any nuisance or hazardous feature involved is suitably separated from adjacent uses; excessive vehicular traffic will not be generated on minor residential streets; and a vehicular parking problem will not be created:

1. In any zoning district: special events operated by non-profit, eleemosynary organizations.
2. In any zoning district: Christmas tree sales lots operated by non-profit, eleemosynary organizations.
3. In any zoning district: other uses which are similar to (1) and (2) above and which are of a temporary nature where the period of use will not extend beyond thirty (30) days.
4. In any zoning district: mobile homes or RV's used for temporary purposes by any agency of municipal, County, State, or Federal government; provided such uses shall not be or include a residential use.
5. In any zoning district: mobile homes or RV's used as a residence, temporary office, security shelter, or shelter for materials of goods incident to construction on or development of the premises upon which the mobile home or travel trailer is located. Such use shall be strictly limited to the time construction or development is actively underway. In no event shall the use continue more than twelve (12) months without the approval of the Board of County Commissioners and the Board of County Commissioners shall give such approval only upon finding that actual construction is continuing.
6. In agricultural, commercial, and industrial districts: temporary religious or revival activities in tents.
7. In agricultural districts: In addition to the principal residential dwelling, two (2) additional mobile homes may be used as an accessory residence, provided that such mobile homes are occupied by persons related by the grandparent, parent, step-parent, adopted parent, sibling, child, stepchild, adopted child or grandchild of the family occupying the principal residential use. Such mobile homes are exempt from lot area requirements. A temporary use permit for such mobile homes may be granted for a time period up to five (5) years. The permit is valid for occupancy of the specified family member as indicated on Family Relationship Affidavit and Agreement which shall be recorded in the Clerk of the Courts by the applicant.

The Family Relationship Affidavit and Agreement shall include but not be limited to:

- a. Specify the family member to reside in the additional mobile home;
- b. Length of time permit is valid;
- c. Site location of mobile home on property and compliance with all other conditions not conflicting with this section for permitting as set forth in these land development regulations. Mobile homes shall not be located within required yard setback areas and shall not be located within twenty (20) feet of any other building;
- d. Responsibility for non ad-valorem assessments;
- e. Inspection with right of entry onto the property, but not into the mobile home by the County to verify compliance with this section. The Land Development Regulation Administrator, and other authorized representatives are hereby authorized to make such inspections and take such actions as may be required to enforce the provisions of this Section and;
- f. Shall be hooked up to appropriate electrical service, potable well and sanitary sewer facilities (bathroom and septic tank) that have been installed pursuant to permits issued by the Health Department and County Building and Zoning Department, where required.
- g. Recreational vehicles (RV's) as defined by these land development regulations are not allowed under this provision (see Section 14.10.2#10).
- h. Requirements upon expiration of permit. Unless extended as herein provided, once a permit expires the mobile home shall be removed from the property within six (6) months of the date of expiration.

The property owner may apply for one or more extensions for up to two (2) years by submitting a new application, appropriate fees and family relationship residence affidavit agreement to be approved by the Land Development Regulation Administrator.

Previously approved temporary use permits would be eligible for extensions as amended in this section.

- 8. In shopping centers within Commercial Intensive districts only: mobile recycling collection units. These units shall operate only between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. and shall be subject to the review of the Land Development Regulation Administrator. Application for permits shall include

written confirmation of the permission of the shopping center owner and a site plan which includes distances from buildings, roads, and property lines. No permit shall be valid for more than thirty (30) days within a twelve (12) month period, and the mobile unit must not remain on site more than seven (7) consecutive days. Once the unit is moved off-site, it must be off-site for six (6) consecutive days.

9. In agriculture and environmentally sensitive area districts: a single recreational vehicle as described on permit for living, sleeping, or housekeeping purposes for one-hundred eighty (180) consecutive days from date that permit is issued, subject to the following conditions:

- a. Demonstrate a permanent residence in another location.
- b. Meet setback requirements.
- c. Shall be hooked up to or have access to appropriate electrical service, potable well and sanitary sewer facilities (bathroom and septic tank) that have been installed pursuant to permits issued by the Health Department and County Building and Zoning Department, where required.
- d. Upon expiration of the permit the recreational vehicle shall not remain on property parked or stored and shall be removed from the property for 180 consecutive days.
- e. Temporary RV permits are renewable only after one (1) year from issuance date of any prior temporary permit.

Temporary RV permits existing at the effective date of this amendment may be renewed for one (1) additional temporary permit in compliance with these land development regulations, as amended. Recreational vehicles as permitted in this section are not to include RV parks.

Appropriate conditions and safeguards may include, but are not limited to, reasonable time limits within which the action for which temporary use permit is requested shall be begun or completed, or both. Violation of such conditions and safeguards, when made a part of the terms under which the special permit is granted, shall be deemed a violation of these land development regulations and punishable as provided in Article 15 of these land development regulations.

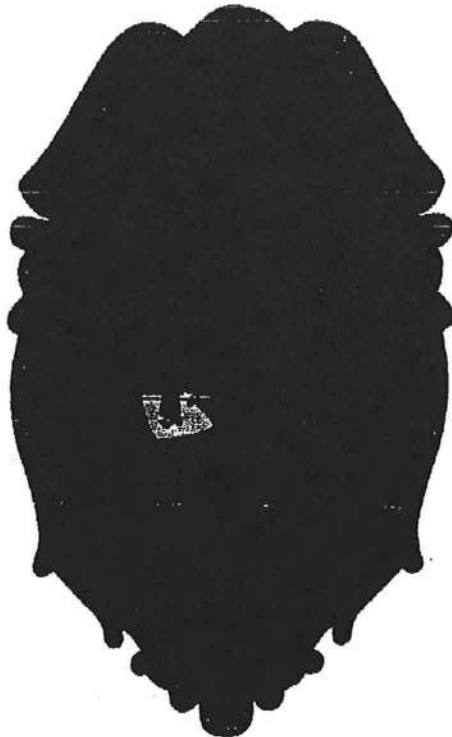

SYNOPSIS:

On 07/25/2007, at approximately 1916 hours, Columbia County Fire Rescue requested the assistance of the State Fire Marshal's Office at the scene of a residential structure fire. I responded the same date, arriving on scene at approximately 2110 hours. Upon arrival I met with Chief Dennis Killebrew (CCFR) and Deputies Tyler and Brown and Sergeant Chris Sharp of the Columbia County Sheriff's Office and the facts and circumstances of the case were discussed.

The fire occurred at 205 NW Adrienne Glen Rd, Lake City, FL, on 07/25/2007, at approximately 1745 hours. No injuries or fatalities were reported as a result of this fire. Weather at the time of the fire was clear and not a contributing factor to this fire. Electrical utilities were provided to the residence at the time of the fire. Detective Andy Redding, K-9 Molly, and Detective Young of the State Fire Marshal's Office also responded to assist in the investigation.

As a result of this investigation, occupant Slater, Glenn Douglas was arrested and charged with arson of an unoccupied structure and cruelty to animals.

SCENE DESCRIPTION:

The scene is described as a double wide mobile home, situated on a wooded lot in a rural residential neighborhood with homes of similar nature surrounding it. Exterior wall construction was wood frame with synthetic siding, with shingled roofing. A plank deck/steps was located at the front door and laundry room door to the left of the front door. A sliding glass door was located at the rear of the home.

FIRE SCENE EXAMINATION:

Fire scene examination was conducted in a systematic manner with attention given to relevant details. Fire scene examination was initiated with an inspection of burn patterns and fire damage to the exterior of the home, beginning at the front of the residence and conducted around the residence in a counter-clockwise manner. Exterior examination revealed minor fire and heat damage at the roof line, with wall burn-through limited primarily to an upward/outward pattern on the rear wall, corresponding subsequently to the stove top in the kitchen. This area was the lowest burn observed to the exterior of the residence. Roof failure was observed to have occurred to the rear half of the residence, with resulting consumption of roof framework. The front half of the roof structure remained intact.

I then conducted an examination of the interior of the residence, beginning at areas of least damage, moving to areas of greatest damage. Fire, heat, smoke and water damage were observed in varying degrees throughout the residence,

with high burn patterns consistently throughout the home. Inspection of the master bedroom revealed the remains of a small breed dog, lying on the floor near the entrance to the room. Upon inspection of the kitchen area, I observed that area of lowest burn not attributed to burning fall-down debris, was a "V" shaped pattern directly over the stove top, ending on the same plane as the top of the stove control panel. On the stove, I observed a cast-iron style skillet with a single looped handle, placed on the right rear burner. Closer inspection of the skillet and surrounding stove top revealed that, based on debris within the skillet and lack of debris underneath, the skillet had been in place prior to the fire. To the right of the skillet, on the floor, atop a large debris pile, I observed a heavily melted pot with what appeared to be several chicken leg quarters inside. Placement of the pot in relation to fallen debris indicated that the pot had not been in that location prior to the fire, and it appears that the pot was moved to that location during suppression efforts. Inspection of the area of wall behind the stove below the stove surface revealed a protected area, with floor level damage as the result of fallen debris. Closer inspection of the bottoms of the skillet and pot revealed a lack of coil patterns, and inspection of the leg quarters did not reveal significant charring. Accidental ignition from the pot of chicken on the stove could be eliminated due to the lack of combustible materials within the pot, also indicating that the stove and contents had been tampered with prior to the fire.

LATENT INVESTIGATION:

While en route to the scene, I made contact with Sgt. Sharp of Columbia County Sheriff's Office and Volunteer firefighter Steve White of Columbia County Fire Rescue. I met with them, prior to arriving on scene, at the intersection of US 41 and Fallen Creek Road. White advised that after leaving the scene of the fire, he observed, at our location, a smoldering cloth garment and blue in color BIC lighter on the shoulder of US 41, which Sgt. Sharp secured until my arrival, at which time I collected both items. The garment was sent to the State Fire Marshal's Office Laboratory for analysis of presence of ignitable liquids and the lighter was sent to FDLE for the analysis of fingerprint evidence. (Subsequent investigation has not shown a relation to these items and the structure fire at this time).

I then followed Sgt. Sharp to the scene, where I also met with Deputies Chris Brown and Terry Tyler of Columbia County Sheriff's Office. Deputy Brown advised that he arrested Slater at the time of the fire, for domestic battery. I then made contact with the owner of the home, Belcher, Darlene D (W/F 11/21/1964). She stated that earlier in the evening, at approximately 1715, she arrived home and began cooking, using a two handled pressure cooker-style pot with no lid, to boil chicken in water, to cook chicken noodle soup. She stated that she used the right front burner, because it was a larger burner. She stated that no other pots, pans or other cooking utensils were on the stove when she was cooking. She stated that Slater arrived home at approximately 1730, and began shouting at her, then shook her by her shoulders and slapped the glasses off her face. She stated that she is sure that she turned off the stove, then left the residence, and called the Sheriff's Office as she was leaving the driveway, to report the incident. She stated that she was advised by the Sheriff's Office to wait at Orblson St for deputies to arrive. She waited there until she saw Slater leave the residence and begin driving towards her. She called the Sheriff's Office again and was advised to drive to the Exxon station at the corner of US 41 and Fallen Creek, to wait on deputies. Slater followed her there. She met with deputies there, and reported the argument. She stated to me that Slater was alone in the home after she left for a least ten to possibly fifteen minutes. I asked her where the skillet that I observed on the stove should have been and she stated that it was stored in the drawer under the stove. She stated that she uses that skillet for frying, and was not frying anything tonight, since she was making chicken noodle soup.

Deputy Brown stated to me that while there, Slater stated at least twice that they need to go check on the house because she (Darlene) left food cooking. After the deputies received the fire call, they responded to the scene, at which time Deputy Tyler reports hearing Slater say that when he left the residence, he noticed the stove on, but did not turn it off because Darlene told him not to touch anything.

Det. Redding, Young and I responded to Columbia County Jail to interview Slater. I read Slater his Miranda rights and asked him if he wished to speak with me. Slater stated that he did not have anything to say because he knew we were going to charge him with arson. Det. Redding asked him if he wished to speak with an attorney, and Slater did not respond in any fashion. Slater then went on to say that he left at the same time Darlene did, and that he did not know the condition of the stove at all. He stated to me, contrary to previous statements to deputies, that he did not know whether the stove was on or off and did not know the placement of any pots on the stove. He did state that he cleaned the stove off the night before. (I had previously interviewed the only other occupant of the home besides Darlene and

there were no other pots on the stove. She stated that at the time she was cooking, the skillet was stored in the drawer under the stove. She also remembers turning off the stove before she left. Darlene stated that she was preparing the leg quarters for chicken noodle soup and had no reason to use the skillet for anything, just the pot with leg quarters.

Darlene stated that after the argument, she left the home first, and called the Sheriff's Office to report the argument. She then drove to Orbison, where she was instructed to wait by dispatch for deputies to arrive. She stated that she then saw Glenn driving towards her, so she left Orbison, and drove to the Exxon station at US 41 to wait for the Sheriff's Office. Darlene stated that Glenn was at the home approximately ten minutes after she left.

Darlene stated that Glenn has threatened numerous times in the past to burn the home, and her sister Ann Dicks reported the burning threat approximately two months ago to the Sheriff's Office. Darlene's son William Belcher stated that he has also heard Glenn threaten to burn the home many times in the past.

Deputy Brown stated to me that while he was making contact with Glenn during the investigation into the argument, that nn spontaneously uttered at least twice that they need to go back and check on the house because she left food cooking. Deputy Tyler stated that Glenn told him that when he left, he noticed the stove on, but did not turn it off because Darlene told him not to touch anything. In my post miranda interview with Glenn, he stated that he did not know whether the stove was on or off and did not know what pans were on the stove. Glenn also stated to me during that interview that during the argument, he took the glasses off her face.

Darlene owned a small dog that also died during the fire, which I observed in the master bedroom on the floor near the doorway.

Fire damage to the home was extensive, with heavy fire, heat, smoke and water damage throughout the home.
