NOTICE TO SWIMMING POOL OWNERS

I Christopher Raines have been informed and I understand that prior to the fina
inspection approval and use of my pool. I will need all the inspections approved and the required fencing
installed in accordance with applicable regulations. The Florida Building Code requires private residential
swimming pools, hot tubs, or non-portable spas containing water over 24 inches deep to meet the following pool barrier safety feature requirements.
pool barrier safety feature requirements

- The pool attoos into the isolated by a barrier at least 4 feet high and installed around the
 persuretes of the pool unless the pool is equipped with a safety cover complying with the
 specifications of American Society Testing and Materials standard E47346-91.
- The barries shall not have any gaps or openings which would allow a child to crawl under, sauteze through or climb over and must be placed no less than 20 inches from the evater's edge.
- Gates located in the cool barrier must open outward away from the pool and be both selfclosing and self-tatching, with a release mechanism not less than 54" above the standing surface at the gate.

The barrier must be separate from any other fence, wall, or other enclosure suffering the yard unless the fence, wall, or other enclosure portion thereof is situated on the perimeter of the pool and meets the pool barrier requirements.

- Where a wall of a dwelling serves as part of the barrier, one of the following shall apply:
 - All doors and first floor windows with a silf height of less than 48" provides affect access from the home to the pool must be equipped with an alarm that has a minimum sound pressure rating of 85 decibels at 10 sect. The starm strik sound immediately, into opening the window or door anless the templicary hypass mechanism is activated OR
 - All doors providing direct access from the home to the pool must be equipped with a self-closing, self-latching device with a release mechanism located at least 54" above the floor.

According to Florida clatures. Chapter 517: Residential Swimming Pool Safety Act; taking to comply with these requirements a antisdement of the second degree, punishable by imprisonment for up to 60 days or a fine of up to \$500, except that no penalty shall be imposed if with 45 days after arrest or issuance of a summons or notice to appear; the pool is equipped with the aforementioned safety features and the responsible person attends a drowning prevention expectation program developed by the Florida Department of Health. I also understand that there are several inspectations required in addition to a final inspection for my swimming pool.
