

- 2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN THE CONSTRUCTION SITE IN A SECURE MANNER. ALL OPEN TRENCHES AND **EXCAVATED AREAS SHALL BE PROTECTED FROM ACCESS** BY THE GENERAL PUBLIC.
- 3. BOUNDARY INFORMATION SHOWN, WAS OBTAINED FROM COLUMBIA COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER ON-LINE GIS
- 4. THE SITE IS LOCATED IN SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH. RANGE 17, COLUMBIA COUNTY, FLORIDA.
- 5. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL IMPLEMENT ALL COMPONENTS OF THE EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL PLAN PRIOR TO ANY EARTH DISTURBING ACTIVITIES. ALL COMPONENTS SHALL BE MAINTAINED BY THE CONTRACTOR UNTIL ALL VEGETATION IS ESTABLISHED, THE ENTIRE PROJECT AREA IS STABILIZED AND THE OWNER HAS ACCEPTED OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE.
- 6. ALL DISTURBED AREAS NOT SODDED SHALL BE SEEDED WITH A MIXTURE OF LONG-TERM VEGETATION AND QUICK **GROWING SHORT-TERM VEGETATION FOR THE FOLLOWING** CONDITIONS. FOR THE MONTHS FROM SEPTEMBER THROUGH MARCH. THE MIX SHALL CONSIST OF 70 POUNDS PER ACRE OF LONG-TERM SEED AND 20 POUNDS PER ACRE OF WINTER RYE. FOR THE MONTHS OF APRIL THROUGH AUGUST, THE MIX SHALL CONSIST OF 70 PER ACRE OF LONG-TERM SEED AND 20 POUNDS PER ACRE OF MILLET.
- 7. THE LOCATION OF THE UTILITIES SHOWN IN THE PLANS ARE APPROXIMATE ONLY. THE EXACT LOCATION SHALL BE **DETERMINED BY THE CONTRACTOR DURING** CONSTRUCTION. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROTECT ALL LITH ITIES WITHIN THE PROJECT AREA
- 8. ALL SITE CONSTRUCTION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH COLUMBIA COUNTY LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS.
- 9. CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE ALL WORK WITH OTHER CONTRACTORS WITHIN PROJECT AREA.
- 10. THIS PROJECT IS TO BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE F.D.O.T. STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION (CURRENT EDITION) AND THE F.D.O.T. STANDARD PLANS FOR ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION (CURRENT EDITION), AWWA SPECIFICATIONS, AND COLUMBIA COUNTY DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
- 11.IF UNSUITABLE MATERIAL IS ENCOUNTERED DURING GRADING, CONTRACTOR SHALL REMOVE UNSUITABLE MATERIAL TO A DEPTH OF 24" BELOW FINISHED GRADE WITHIN THE CONSTRUCTION LIMITS.
- 12. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE COUNTY AT LEAST 48 HOURS PRIOR TO BEGINNING OF CONSTRUCTION.
- 13. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT A NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION COMMENCEMENT TO THE WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT AT LEAST 48 HOURS PRIOR TO THE **BEGINNING OF CONSTRUCTION.**

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14.NO WORK SHALL BE PERFORMED ON SATURDAY OR SUNDAY WITHOUT WRITTEN NOTIFICATION TO THE COUNTY AND COUNTY ENGINEER.

15. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE AN AS-BUILT SURVEY MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF CHAPTER 61G17 F.A.C. FOR THE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS. INCLUDE HORIZONTAL AND VERTICAL DIMENSIONAL DATA SO THAT IMPROVEMENTS ARE LOCATED AND DELINEATED RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARY. PROVIDE SUFFICIENT DETAILED DATA TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE IMPROVEMENTS WERE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PLANS, A COPY OF THE AS-BUILT SURVEY MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE

16. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT A NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM NOTICE OF INTENT ALONG WITH SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AT LEAST 48 HOURS PRIOR TO BEGINNING OF CONSTRUCTION. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL PERMIT FEES.

17. ALL CONCRETE SLABS ABUTTING EXTERIOR WALLS SHALL BE TREATED FOR TERMITES.






ETAIL JRRUNG DRY STORA LAKE CITY, FLORIDA Ø S NOTE **ENERAL**

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EROSION CONTROL NOTES

- 1. THIS EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL PLAN COMPLIES WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE "FLORIDA DEVELOPMENT MANUAL" AND THE "FLORIDA EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL INSPECTOR'S MANUAL".
- 2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ADHERE TO COLUMBIA COUNTY, SRWMD, AND OTHER GOVERNING AUTHORITIES FOR EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL REGULATIONS. IF THE CONTRACTOR NEEDS TO CHANGE THIS PLAN TO MORE EFFECTIVELY CONTROL EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL USE BMP'S FROM THE "FLORIDA EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL INSPECTOR'S MANUAL".
- 3. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ADJUST AND REVISE THIS PLAN TO MEET ACTUAL FIELD CONDITIONS. ANY REVISIONS SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE REVIEWING AGENCIES.
- 4. SEDIMENT AND EROSION CONTROL FACILITIES, STORM DRAINAGE FACILITIES AND DETENTION BASINS SHALL BE INSTALLED PRIOR TO ANY OTHER CONSTRUCTION.
- 5. EROSION CONTROL MEASURES SHALL BE INSPECTED WEEKLY AND AFTER EACH RAINFALL OF 0.5 INCHES OR GREATER, AND REPAIRED OR REPLACED AS NECESSARY.
- 6. SEDIMENT AND EROSION CONTROL MEASURES SHALL NOT BE REMOVED UNTIL ALL CONSTRUCTION IS COMPLETE AND UNTIL A PERMANENT GROUND COVER HAS BEEN
- 7. ALL OPEN DRAINAGE SWALES SHALL BE GRASSED AND RIPRAP SHALL BE PLACED AS REQUIRED TO CONTROL EROSION.
- 8. SILT FENCES SHALL BE LOCATED ON SITE TO PREVENT SEDIMENT AND EROSION FROM LEAVING PROJECT LIMITS.
- 9. CONTRACTOR SHALL PLACE A DOUBLE ROW OF SILT FENCE IN AREAS WHERE RUNOFF FROM DISTURBED AREAS MAY ENTER WETLANDS.
- 10.DURING CONSTRUCTION AND AFTER CONSTRUCTION IS COMPLETE. ALL STRUCTURES SHALL BE CLEANED OF ALL DEBRIS AND EXCESS SEDIMENT.
- 11.ALL GRADED AREAS SHALL BE STABILIZED IMMEDIATELY WITH A TEMPORARY FAST-GROWING COVER AND/OR MULCH.
- 12. A PAD OF RUBBLE RIP RAP SHALL BE PLACED AT THE BOTTOM OF ALL COLLECTION FLUMES AND COLLECTION PIPE OUTLETS. GRANITE OR LIMESTONE RIPRAP IS REQUIRED, NO BROKEN CONCRETE WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- 13. ALL SIDE SLOPES STEEPER THAN 3:1 SHALL BE ADEQUATELY PROTECTED FROM EROSION THROUGH THE USE OF SYNTHETIC BALES OR SODDING.
- 14. ALL STABILIZATION PRACTICES SHALL BE INITIATED AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE IN AREAS OF THE JOB WHERE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES HAVE TEMPORARILY OR PERMANENTLY STOPPED, BUT IN NO CASE SHALL THE DISTURBED AREA BE LEFT UNPROTECTED FOR MORE THAN SEVEN DAYS.
- 15. ALL WASTE GENERATED ON THE PROJECT SHALL BE DISPOSED OF BY THE CONTRACTOR IN AREAS PROVIDED BY CONTRACTOR.
- 16.LOADED HAUL TRUCKS SHALL BE COVERED WITH TARPS.
- 17.EXCESS DIRT SHALL BE REMOVED DAILY.
- 18.THIS PROJECT SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL WATER QUALITY STANDARDS. PERMIT REQUIRED FROM SRWMD HAS BEEN OBTAINED.
- 19. QUALIFIED PERSONNEL SHALL INSPECT THE AREA USED FOR STORAGE OF STOCKPILES, THE SILT FENCE AND STRAW BALES. THE LOCATION WHERE VEHICLES ENTER OR EXIT THE SITE, AND THE DISTURBED AREAS THAT HAVE NOT BEEN FINALLY STABILIZED, AT LEAST ONCE EVERY SEVEN CALENDAR DAYS AND WITHIN 24 HOURS OF THE END OF A STORM OF 0.5 INCHES OR GREATER.
- 20.SITES THAT HAVE BEEN FINALLY STABILIZED WITH SOD OR GRASSING SHALL BE INSPECTED AT LEAST ONCE EVERY WEEK.
