

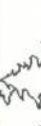

 - Windows: Multiple windows, including a large central window and a small octagonal window.
 - Doors: A central entrance door and two garage doors.
 - Roofline: 2x8 rake fascia and 2x4 WP trim.
 - Foundation: 20" skirting.
