**ORDER OF SUMMARY ADMINISTRATION AND DETERMINATION
OF HOMESTEAD STATUS OF REAL PROPERTY AND DETERMINATION
OF EXEMPT STATUS OF PERSONAL PROPERTY**

(Intestate)

On the petition of WILLIE V. MOSLEY for summary administration of the estate of JACK MOSLEY, deceased, the Court finding that the decedent died on January 8, 2012; that all interested persons have been served proper notice of the petition and hearing, or have waived notice thereof; that the material allegations of the petition are true; and that the decedent's estate qualifies for summary administration and an Order of Summary Administration should be entered, and

1. The decedent died intestate and was domiciled in Columbia County, Florida;
2. The decedent was survived by his wife, WILLIE V. MOSLEY;
3. Decedent's homestead is validly devised;
4. At the time of death, the decedent owned and resided on the real property and owned the personal property described in the petition.

ADJUDGED that:

1. There be immediate distribution of the assets of the decedent as follows:

Willie V. Mosley	189 SW Thames Street Fort White, FL 32038	100% of assets including exempt homestead property located at 189 SW Thames Street, Fort White, FL 32038

2. Those to whom specified parts of the decedent's estate are assigned by this order shall be entitled to receive and collect the same, and to maintain actions to enforce the right.

3. Debtors of the decedent, those holding property of the decedent, and those with whom securities or other property of the decedent are registered, are authorized and empowered to comply with this order by paying, delivering or transferring to those specified above the parts of the decedent's estate assigned to them by this order, and the persons so paying, delivering or transferring shall not be accountable to anyone else for the property.

ADJUDGED FURTHER that the following described property (the "Property"): 189 SW Thames Street, Fort White, Florida 32038, legally described as: *All Block 80 & S ½ of Block 81. ORB 552-129, DC 1162-1525;*

constituted the homestead of the decedent within the meaning of Section 4 Article X of the Constitution of the State of Florida.

ADJUDGED FURTHER that title to the Property was validly devised to and constitutional exemption from the claims of decedent's creditors inured to WILLIE V. MOSLEY, whose address is 189 SW Thames Street, Fort White, Florida 32038.
