

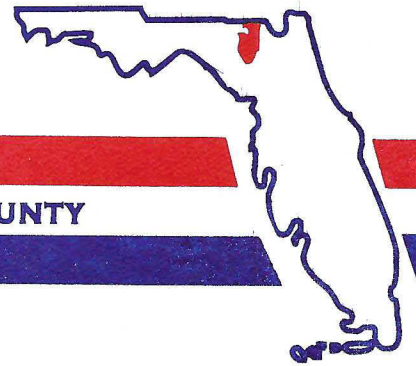

**Re:** Emergency Well Replacement

This memo provides additional information for the emergency well replacement at Southside Sports Complex. Last week the irrigation well at Girls Softball started having issues with low volumes and then kicking out power which caused an electrician several hours of trouble shooting figuring out the well had caved in causing pump to overheat as it was pumping mud which in return caused the electrical issues. With that being said this created an emergency situation as we are already extremely dry and hand watering turf. Graham Electric doesn't have the ability to drill a well, A&B Well Drilling was two to three weeks out and Hall's pump and well was a week out but could work us in between other jobs. Fargo Well & Pump do not drill wells. SRWMD was able to get us the permit back first thing Monday morning and Hall's moved in Monday afternoon. As of today the well is complete, everything was being finalized today and should be back in operation tomorrow. If not in operation tomorrow, I will have to have an employee work the weekend hand watering as we cannot afford to lose turf. If there are any other questions about this emergency replacement of the irrigation well please advise.
