Re: Resolution 2020R-40: Volumetric Pricing for Class III Waste – Winfield Landfill

Date: September 10, 2020

As discussed at the Board’s last meeting, staff have developed the attached resolution that would, if approved, create a volumetric fee structure for Class III waste delivered to the Winfield Landfill in standard-sized rolloff containers.

The fees would be as follows:

- b.1. Class III Volumetric – Class III waste delivered and compactly and fully fitting within 20-, 30- or 40-yard containers shall be charged \$4.50 per cubic yard regardless of tonnage.

It is important to note the language “regardless of tonnage”. This is a flat rate based entirely on the type and size of container being used to deliver waste to the landfill. There will be no measurements to determine whether the container is filled or any accounting for weight. The tonnage rates for Class III waste have not been removed from the rate schedule.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR COLUMBIA
COUNTY, FLORIDA, SETTING TIPPAGE FEES FOR THE COLUMBIA COUNTY-
WINFIELD SOLID WASTE FACILITY.**

WHEREAS, the Columbia County Board of County Commissioners has established tippage fees at the Columbia County - Winfield Solid Waste Facility to cover operating expenses of the Winfield Solid Waste Facility, closure expenses of the Columbia County Central Landfill, and to provide a recycling program for the residents of Columbia County, and;

WHEREAS, such fees have previously been set by Resolution Numbers 79R-36, 81R-15, 81R-22, 87R-19, 90R-17, 90R-53, 92R-16, 95R-43, 95R-76, 2003R-44, 2013R-46, and 2014R-22; and

WHEREAS, the Columbia County Board of County Commissioners wishes to exempt individuals who live outside the city limits who, transport those items known as “white goods” directly to the Columbia County-Winfield Solid Waste Facility from payment of a tippage fee;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF COLUMBIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS**

1. The fees to be charged for the use of the Columbia County - Winfield Solid Waste Facility are hereby amended as follows:

- i. Mobile Home Disposal- \$250.00 per side
All appliances, electronics and food waste must be removed. Tires and wheels must be removed after dropping. The tires would be charged at the tire disposal rate. Axles and tongue can be removed after delivery. Frames will not be returned. 24-hr. notice would be required to prepare a location for easy access for customer to remove tires, wheels, axles and tongue. Cannot accept mobile homes during rainy conditions.

- j. Septic Waste Disposal - \$0.25 per gallon
(EMERGENCY USE ONLY)
Residential only. No commercial or industrial septic. No hazardous content from any source. The hauler must register with the Winfield Solid Waste Facility and comply with all applicable rules and regulations

2. The rates hereby established shall become effective immediately and shall supersede all previously established Columbia County-Winfield Solid Waste Facility fees as provided by prior resolutions provided however, that these rates shall not affect any present contracts in which fees are specified until such time as those contracts expire.
