Dear Mr. Ford,

For the Board's review and approval, attached is the Constitutional Officer's Financial Report for the Fiscal Year 2020-2021, for the Office of the Sheriff. Attached you will find a check in the amount of \$509,586.50 to the Board of County Commissioners which represents collected revenues for charges for services rendered and reimbursements, as well as, interest earnings and other miscellaneous revenues. The returned funds are summarized as follows:

\$ 385,133.38 Charges for Services/Reimbursements 122,472.12 Miscellaneous revenues collected
1,981.00 Interest earnings
\$ 509,586.50 Total Year End Close

We are requesting the return of \$82,651.25 of these funds as Budget Amendment #1 for the current Fiscal Year 2021/2022. This amount is the total amount of an outstanding purchase order to Motorola for 55 Sierra Wireless Routers (MP70). These routers are require to replace the Verizon Jetpacks that are currently in use. The MP70 routers will significantly enhance the LTE signal for our patrol vehicles which is our primary internet connection to the vehicles. These routers will eliminate problems incurred by the existing Jetpacks due to heat and sunlight which damage the jetpack batteries and render them inoperable. Additionally, the routers will enable the upload of our in-car video recordings without having to sit at our Operations Building for extended periods of time to do so.
