1. Nature and purpose of agenda item:

Based upon the recommendation of the Department of Health, on August 6, 2021 the County entered into an agreement with Curative Inc, to provide Pop-Up COVID Testing in Columbia County. This First Amendment will extend the contract from November 13, 2021 to February 13, 2022. All other conditions remain the same. There is no cost to County except utilities at County facility.

Approve the amendment with the Curative Inc. to extend pop-up COVID testing

First Amendment to Pop-Up Testing Agreement

This First Amendment to Pop-Up Testing Agreement (the "Amendment") is entered into effective as of Effective Date (the "Effective Date"), between Curative Inc., with offices located at 430 South Cataract Ave, San Dimas, CA 91773 with clinical laboratories certified under the Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments of 1988 (CLIA) (collectively, "Curative") and Columbia County, Florida, a political subdivision of the State of Florida ("Partner"). Curative and PARTNER shall be referred to hereafter individually as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties" to this Agreement.

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into an agreement on August 6, 2021 for Covid-19 testing within Columbia County, Florida that are generally available to the public (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the Agreement as more specifically set forth below.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

1. The Agreement is thereby amended to extend the original end date of November 13, 2021 to February 13, 2022.
2. Except as expressly provided herein, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement not affected by this Amendment are incorporated herein and shall remain in full force and effect. If there is conflict between this Amendment and the Agreement, the terms of this Amendment shall control.
3. This Amendment and the Agreement constitute the entire Agreement between the Parties related to the subject matter thereof and supersedes any prior understandings. This Amendment may be amended only by written amendments duly executed by the parties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties have caused this First Amendment to the Pop-Up Testing Agreement to be executed by their duly authorized representatives as of the Effective Date.
