SUBJECT:	Department of the Navy – National Naval Aviation Museum Aircraft Loan Agreement Amendment

Attached you will find a letter dated July 11, 2017 from the Department of Navy in which they are notifying Borrowers of National Naval Aviation Museum (NNAM) aircraft of an amendment to the respective Borrowers current loan agreement.

As you are aware, Columbia County entered into a Standard Renewal Loan Agreement on January 4, 2017 for the A-7E Corsair II aircraft, which is loaned to the Columbia County Board of County Commissioners from the National Naval Aviation Museum (NNAM) at Pensacola, Florida.

The attached letter is serving notice of the amendment to the Standard Renewal Loan Agreement which would prohibit the access and entering of aircraft cockpits by the General Public. Walk-ups/ladders to the aircraft cockpits may be allowed in order for the visitor to view the cockpit interior, as long as the cockpit interior is not accessible and that the Borrower has made every attempt to ensure visitor safety.

Additionally, relocation of loaned property for temporary special events (parades, ceremonies, air shows, etc.) is not authorized under any circumstances, without prior expressed written consent of the NNAM. No temporary decorations of any type are authorized to be displayed on any loaned property, for any purpose (special event, seasonal display, ceremonies, etc.).

Only historically based markings, including crew member names, may be used on aircraft and other navy owned equipment and the agreement precludes the use of markings on the equipment for commercial, fundraising, or sponsorship purposes. The Borrower shall obtain expressed written consent from the Lender PRIOR to painting any markings or insignia onto aircraft, especially with respect to names being applied to aircraft. Failure to observe these conditions can result in the immediate repossession of the loaned property by NNAM, at the Borrower's expense.

NNAM is requesting the Board acknowledge the loan agreement revisions as well as abiding by its conditions by signing the letter and returning the acknowledgement to NNAM.

To the Borrowers of National Naval Aviation Museum (NNAM) aircraft

For the reasons of aircraft preservation and, most importantly, public safety, NNAM prohibits the access and entering of aircraft cockpits by the General Public. Walk-ups ladders to the aircraft cockpits may be allowed in order for the visitor to view the cockpit interior, as long as the cockpit interior is not accessible and that the Borrower has made every attempt to ensure visitor safety. This proviso does not include cockpit simulator exhibits.

Additionally, relocation of all loaned property for temporary special events (parades, ceremonies, air shows, etc.) is not authorized under any circumstances, without prior expressed written consent of the NNAM. No temporary decorations of any type are authorized to be displayed on any loaned property, for any purpose (special event, seasonal display, ceremonies, etc.).

Only historically based markings, including crewmember names, may be used on aircraft and other navy owned equipment and this agreement precludes the use of markings on this equipment for commercial, fundraising, or sponsorship purposes. The Borrower shall obtain expressed written consent from the Lender PRIOR to painting any markings or insignia onto aircraft, especially with respect to names being applied to aircraft. Failure to observe these conditions can result in the immediate repossession of the loaned property by NNAM, at the Borrower's expense.
