RE: Herlong/ US 441 SW Quadrant Road

Per previous discussions, and the meeting held between FDOT and County Staff on 6/21/2024, the County is proposing to move forward with the Surveying, Design and Permitting of the "Herlong/441 SW Quadrant Road". This will be labeled as Phase 1 and will include but is not limited to:

- Quadrant Roadway design
- Signalization (at Quadrant intersection with 441)/striping
- Improvements to SW Howell Road
- Stormwater design
- Construction Management of all above items

The County is also preparing, with FDOT's assistance, an RFQ for the remaining consulting work which will be Phase 2, required on the Southern side of the US 441/41-Interstate 75 interchange. These items include but are not limited to:

- Widening
- Signalization/Striping
- Stormwater
- Construction Management of all above items

The County understands and agrees that any large development (over 500 trips/day) in the SW Quadrant of US 441/41 and Interstate 75 will not be permitted until **BOTH** phases are completed, and placed into service.

BOARD MEETS FIRST AND THIRD THURSDAY AT 5:30 P.M.

Interim Concept - Preliminary Delivery Estimates:

- Design (10% of Construction): \$ 1.7 Million
- Right of Way: To be determined by Local Agency
- Construction Total: \$ 16.9 Million
 - Quadrant Road & Howell Rd Portion: \$ 11.2 Million
 - Restriping & Minor Operational Improvements at I-75 Portion: \$ 5.7 Million
- Construction Support (10% of Construction): \$ 1.7 Million

Note: Estimates do not include administrative costs associated with permitting, utility coordination, etc. Overall cost may be lower due to local agency delivery.
