6. Pursuant to Section 337-403(1), Florida Statutes, whenever necessary for the construction, repair, improvement, maintenance, safe and efficient operation, alteration or relocation of all, or any portion of said transportation facility as determined by the Columbia County Public Works Director and/or County Engineer, any or all utilities and appurtenances authorized hereunder, shall be immediately removed from said transportation facility or reset or

relocated thereon as required by the Columbia County Public Works Director and/or County Engineer and at the expense of the PERMITTEE.

7. In case of non-compliance with the County's requirements in effect as of the approval date of this permit, this permit void and the facility will have to be brought into compliance or removed from the right of way at no cost to the County.

8. It is understood and agreed that the rights and privileges herein set out are granted only to the extent of the County's right, title and interest in the land to be entered upon and used by the PERMITTEE, and the PERMITTEE will, at all times, and to the extent permitted by law, assume all risk of and indemnify, defend, and save harmless Columbia County, Florida from any and all loss, damage, cost or expense arising in any manner on account of the exercise or attempted exercise by said PERMITTEE of the aforesaid right and privileges.

9. During construction, all safety regulations of the County shall be observed and the PERMITTEE must take measures, including pacing and the display of safety devices that may be necessary in order to safely conduct the public through the project area in accordance with the Federal Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, as amended for highways.

10. Should the PERMITTEE be desirous of keeping its utilities in place and out of service, the PERMITTEE, by execution of this permit acknowledges its present and continuing ownership of its utilities located between ~~344 NW NULL RD~~ STEVEN FOSTER DR and _____ within the County's right of way as set forth above. PERMITTEE, as its sole expense, shall promptly remove said out of service utilities whenever Columbia County Public Works Director and/or County Engineer determines said removal is in the public interest.

11. Special instructions: Minimum cover of thirty inches (30") will be required at all locations. Columbia County will not be financially responsible for any damage to facilities with less than thirty inches (30") cover. Cables shall not be located within driveway ditches.

12. Additional Stipulations: _____

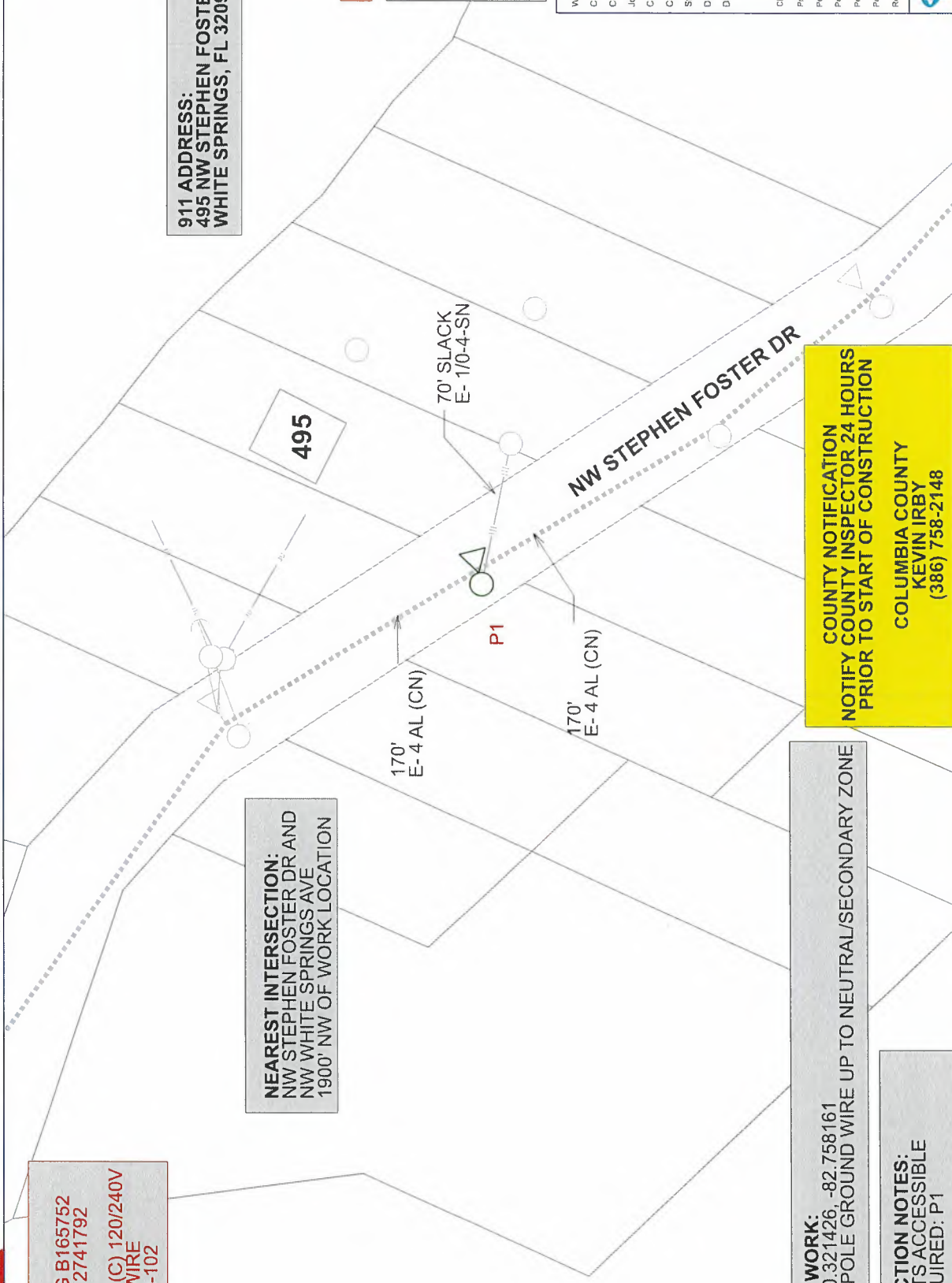

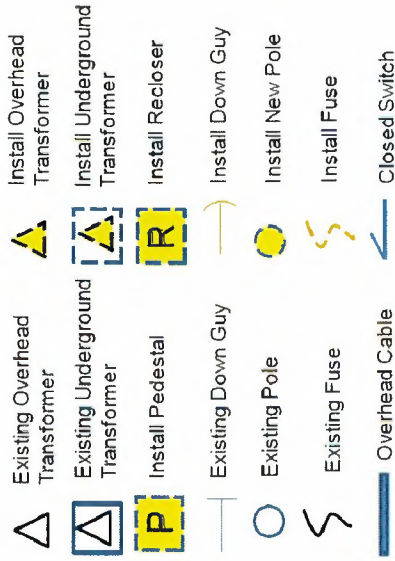

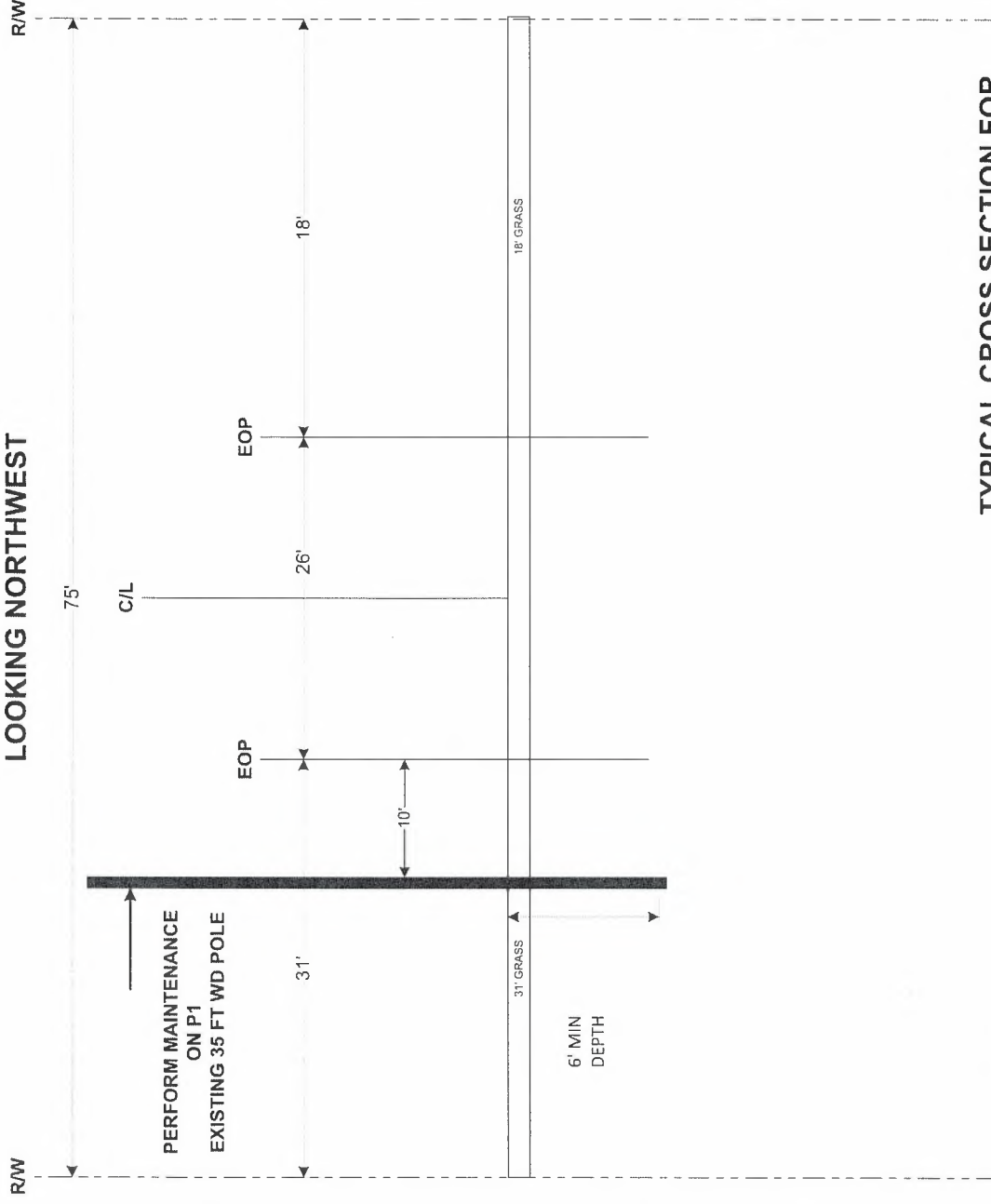
GENERAL CONSTRUCTION NOTES

- DUKE ENERGY TO RESTORE RIGHT OF WAY TO EQUAL OR BETTER THAN EXISTING CONDITION.
- TO AVOID CONFLICTS, CONTRACTOR WILL COORDINATE DEPTH OF UNDERGROUND FACILITIES WITH THE MUNICIPALITY INSPECTOR PRIOR TO BORES BEING INSTALLED.
- MINIMUM DEPTH OF CABLE IN CONDUIT IS 36 INCHES BELOW GRADE. THREE FEET OF SEPARATION FROM EXISTING UTILITIES AND STORM WATER/SEWERS REQUIRED.
- ALL PULL BOX LIDS SHALL BE TRAFFIC RATED WHEN INSTALLED WITHIN THE RIGHT OF WAY.

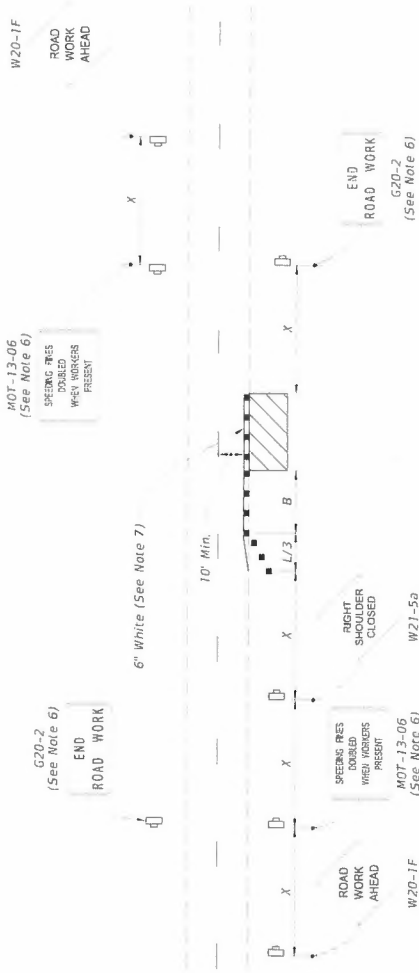

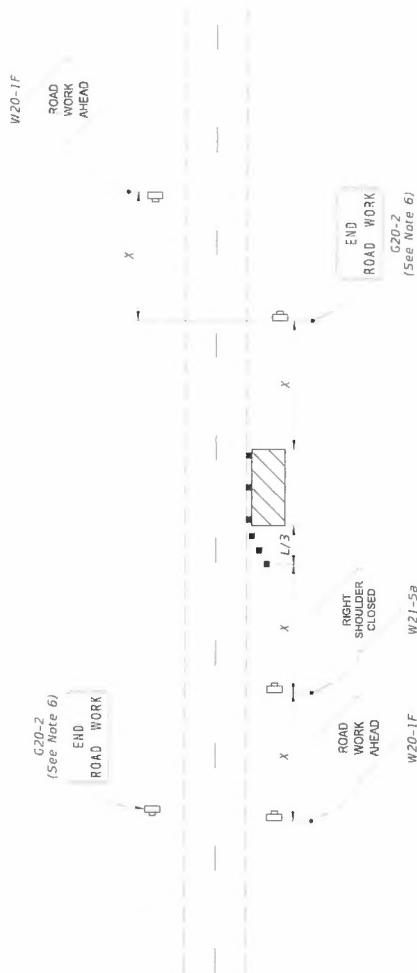
1. This Index applies to Two-Lane, Two-Way and Multilane Roadways, including Medians of divided roadways, with work on the Shoulder.
2. L = Taper Length
X = Work Zone Sign Spacing
B = Buffer Length
See Index 102-600 for "L", "X", "B", and channelizing device spacing values.
3. Where work activities are between 2' and 15' from the edge of traveled way, the Engineer may omit signs and channelizing devices for work operations 60 minutes or less.
4. When four or more work vehicles enter the through traffic lanes in a one hour period (excluding establishing and terminating the work area), use a flagger or lane closure to accommodate work vehicle ingress and egress.
5. For work less than 2' from the traveled way and work zone speed is greater than 45 MPH, use a lane closure.
6. The "Speeding Fines Doubled When Workers Present" signs (MOT-13-06) and "End Road Work" signs (G20-2) along with the associated work zone sign spacing distances may be omitted when the work operation is in place for 24 hours or less.
7. Temporary pavement markings may be omitted when the work operation is in place for 3 days or less.
8. Omit "Shoulder Closed" signs (W21-5a) along with associated work zone sign spacing distances for work on the median.
9. When there is no paved shoulder, the "Worker" sign (W21-1) may be used instead of the "Shoulder Closed" sign (W21-5a).

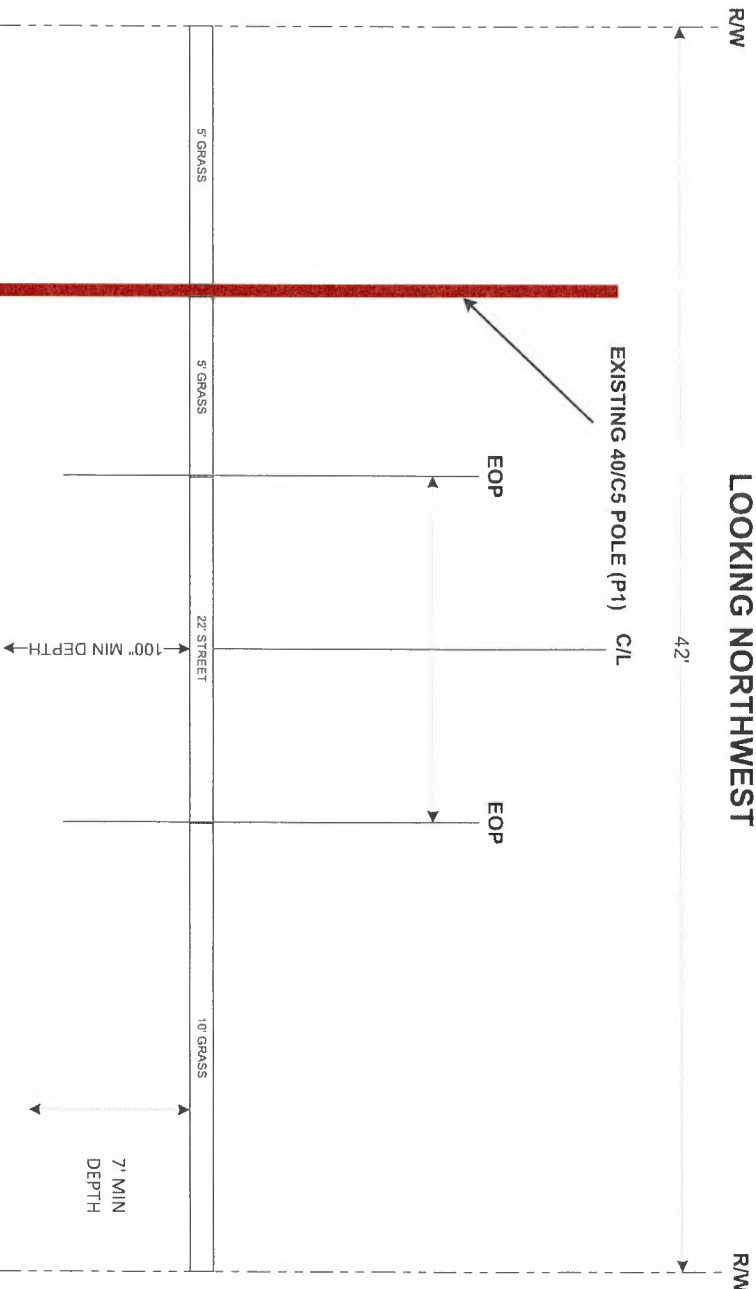

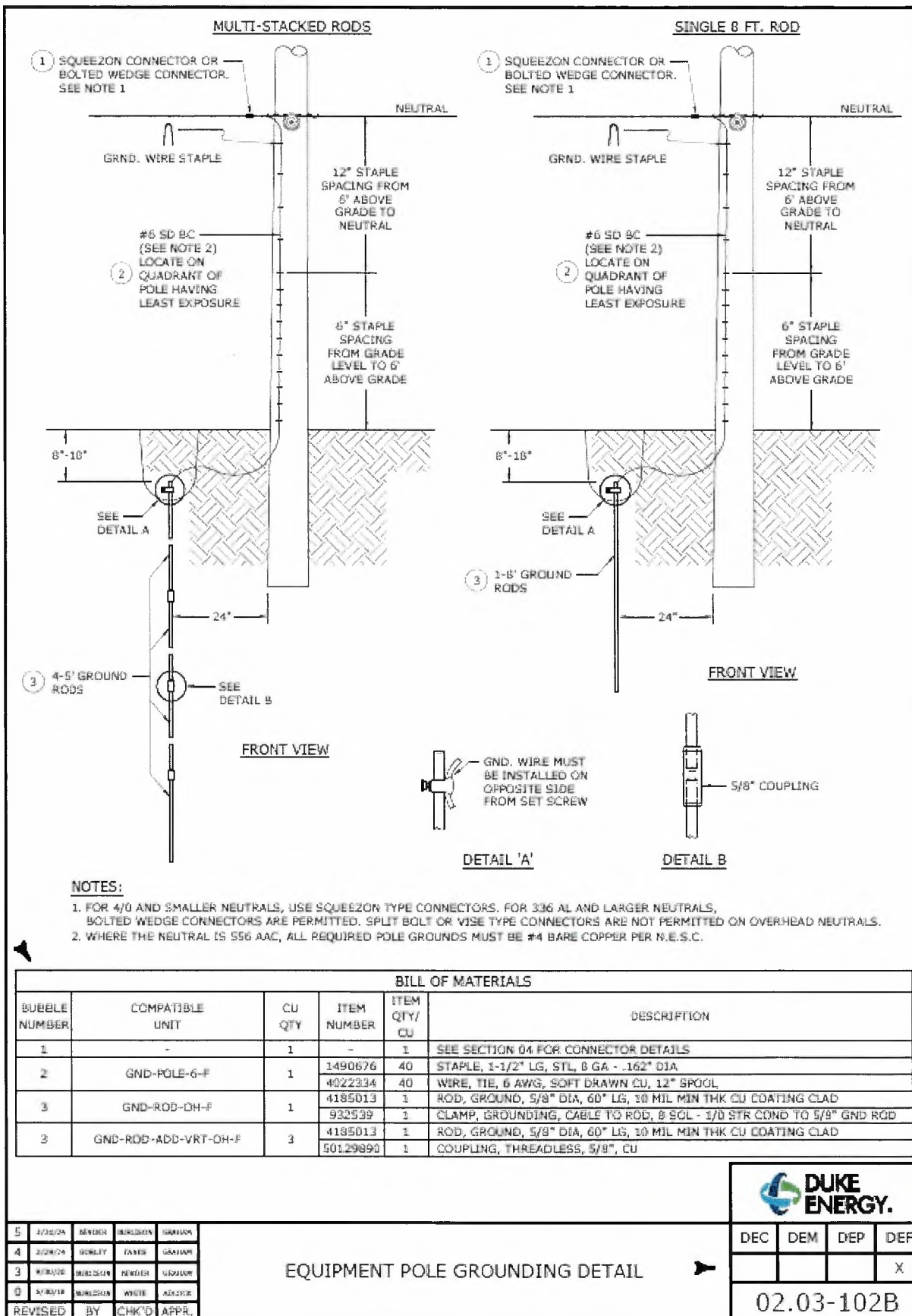

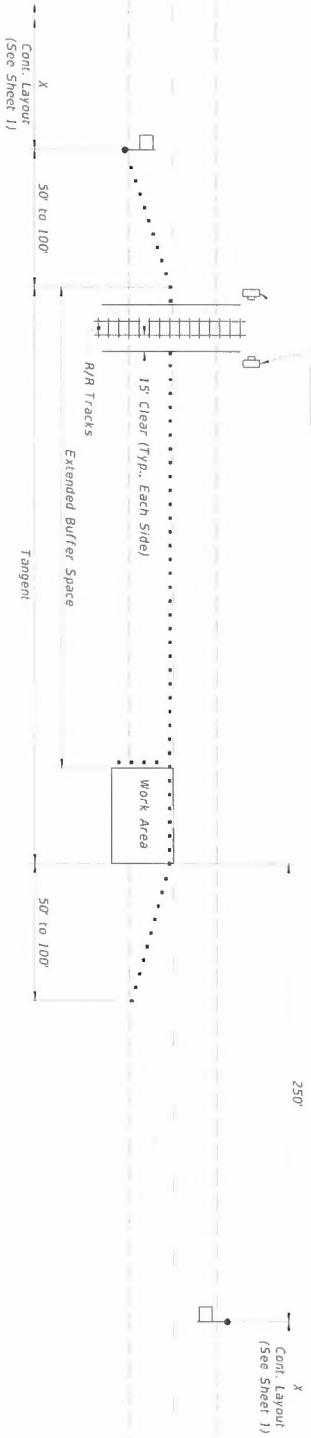
TYPICAL CROSS SECTION FOR NW STEPHEN FOSTER DR

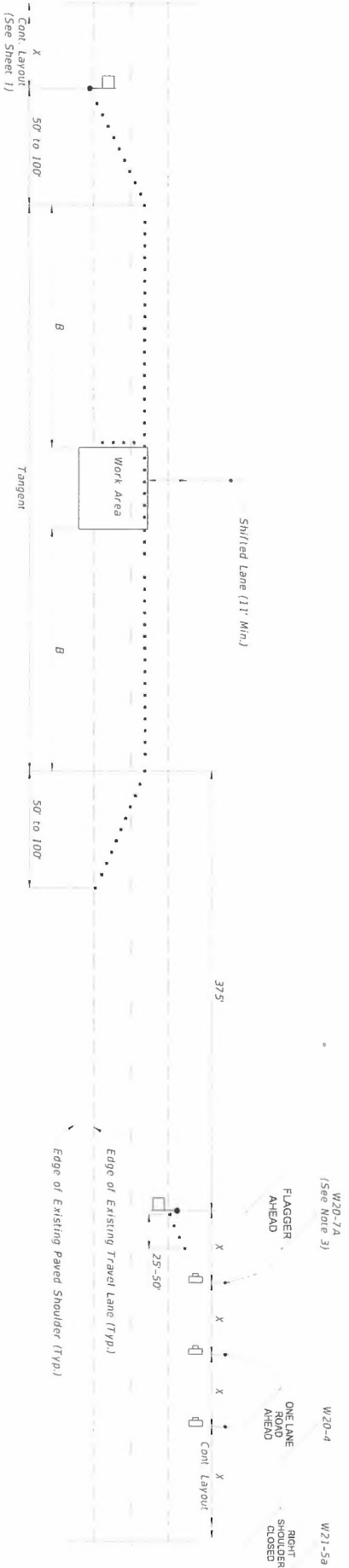
