## **Economic Development Board**

March 20, 2013

### Minutes of February 06, 2013

- (a) North Florida Intermodal Park. Allison Megrath wasn't present to give the update.
- (b) **Demand/Capacity Study I-75/Hwy. 47**. Director Quillen reviewed a master plan showing a diagram for wastewater and reclaimed water lines.

Wendell Johnson gave a brief overview of the City's plans moving forward and focusing on the area east of I-75. He also discussed demand capacity.

## **Director's Report**

(a) The *Columbia County Industrial Park* sign that faces SR 100 has fallen into a state of disrepair over the years. Jeff Simmons asked if it would be possible to ask the county to correct the problem and be in charge of maintenance. There was discussion.

It was agreed that Chum O'neal would be asked to inspect the sign to determine what it will take to repair it. There was further discussion that perhaps the Committee 100 should be responsible for bringing the sign up to standards, and then discussing with the County the possibility of having them assist with general sign maintenance and mowing around the sign.

- (b) FPL Buildings and Sites database is being compiled and can be viewed soon at: <u>www.ccfledd.com</u>. Director Quillen asked the Board to submit suggestions for other properties that maybe be added, ideas for improvements, etc.
- (c) Director Quillen and the Chamber of Commerce met with the Gibson Group, owners of the Gleason's Corner Mall and with Retails Strategies, a consulting group. The meeting included discussion on pursuing a vision for retail in Lake City, Columbia County.

## Other

Director Quillen reported a productive and encouraging meeting last week with **Norfolk Southern**, which transports to the North and South. He said that he would continue to pursue and work with Norfolk on a spur, as well as working with CSX. Director Quillen will report as things develop. If it is possible, having a second railway could prove to be extremely beneficial to Columbia County.

There was a consensus to cancel the **April 03 meeting**. The Economic Development Board will meet again on **May 01 at 8:30 a.m.**

## RETAIL \$\$\$

The opportunity to pursue retail that originated with the Economic Development department has been handed off to the Lake City | Columbia County Chamber to vet. The Chamber Board is considering a proposal from Retail Strategies out of Birmingham, AL. This study would include a gap analysis and a peer analysis of similar markets.

#### Unemployment - March 2013

The latest unemployment numbers are out and Columbia County unemployment continues to improve. The unemployment rate for March 2013 is 6.4%. Just a year ago, in March 2012, the unemployment rate was 8.2%. The March 2013 rate of 6.4% is the lowest unemployment rate since 2008 when unemployment averaged 5.5% in Columbia Country. Columbia County unemployment continues to be slightly better than both the Florida and U.S. averages which were 7.0 and 7.6 respectively.

## News

#### North Florida INTERMODAL PARK:

Plum Creek continues to make good progress with development plans on the 2600 acre North Florida INTERMODAL PARK (NFIP). Of particular interest is the fact that a good, open dialogue has been established with the United States Forestry Service and discussions are now ongoing about the location of the much needed rail spur.

#### Workforce Training:

As industry begins to locate and occupy the planned 8 million square feet at the NFIP our greatest need will undoubtedly be providing a skilled and trained workforce. I am happy to report that officials from Florida Gateway College, Plum Creek and Columbia County Economic Development recently met to begin laying plans for a workforce training center. Our plans are to grow this conversation to include existing industry leaders as we seek funding opportunities to build and staff a workforce training facility.

#### **NFIP** Panel Discussions:

During the previous years, many individuals and numerous State Agencies have been involved in the development of Plum Creek's North Florida INTERMODAL PARK. We now have two opportunities to share this story with many others around Florida. The first occasion will be at the June FEDC Conference in Orlando. The second opportunity will be at the American Planning Association 2013 Conference in September and also in Orlando.

## Project Activity

#### **Potential Prospects:**

Two proposals were submitted this past month with a combined capital investment of \$50 million dollars and employment of 130 people.

#### **Bell Road Project:**

County and City officials are working cooperatively together to plan for the needed infrastructure as the 2015 paving project approaches. Determining costs and responsibility is no easy task and I appreciate the cooperation of all parties.
