#### Resolution No. 2016R-14

A resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Columbia County, Florida, authorizing the issuance by the County of a \$6,000,000 Columbia County, Florida gas tax revenue refunding note, series 2016, in order to refund the county's gas tax revenue bond, series 2013 and finance certain additional transportation improvements within the county.
